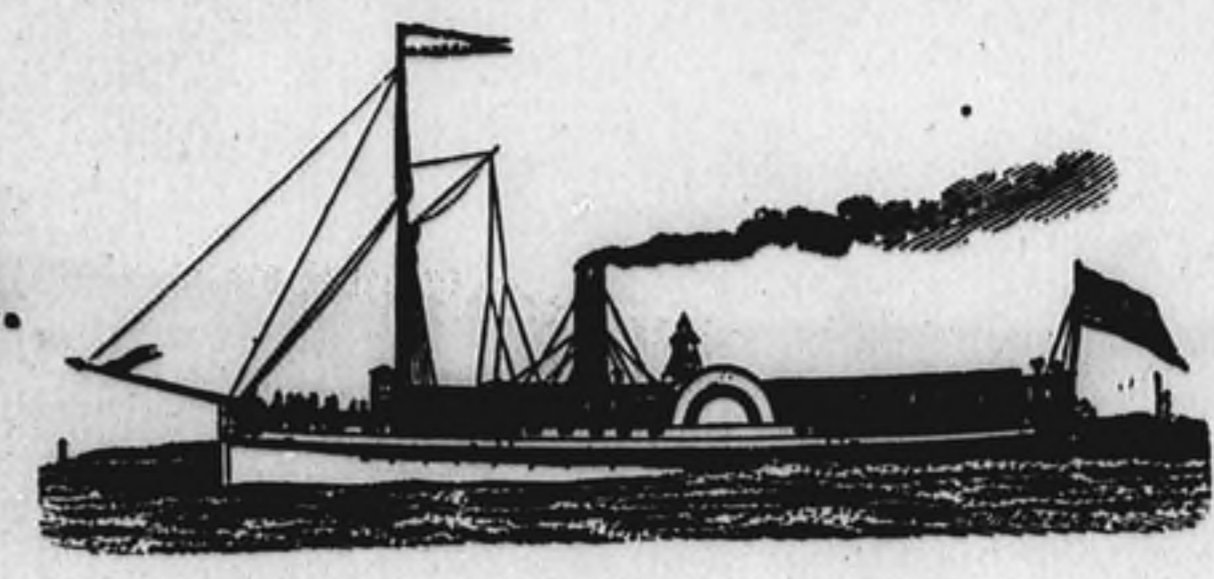

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850. *and act of May 6. 1862.*

*Benjamin Dickey*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N.Y.* and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Canal Boat William Taggart* of *Buffalo* whereof *Seth E. Cowles* is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo* State of *New York* in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of *H. H. Allen* Shipwright her builder, on file in this Office, and dated *June 5-1862*

And *John W. Seaman* surveyor having certified that the said *Canal Boat* or vessel has *one* deck and *no* mast and that her length is *95* feet *inches* her breadth *17 4/10* feet *inches* her depth *9 25/100* feet *inches* and that she measures *One Hundred and twenty nine* tons *5/100* *ninety-fifths* that she is a *Canal Boat* has a *round* stern and *no figure* head.

And the said *Benjamin Dickey* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Canal Boat* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
