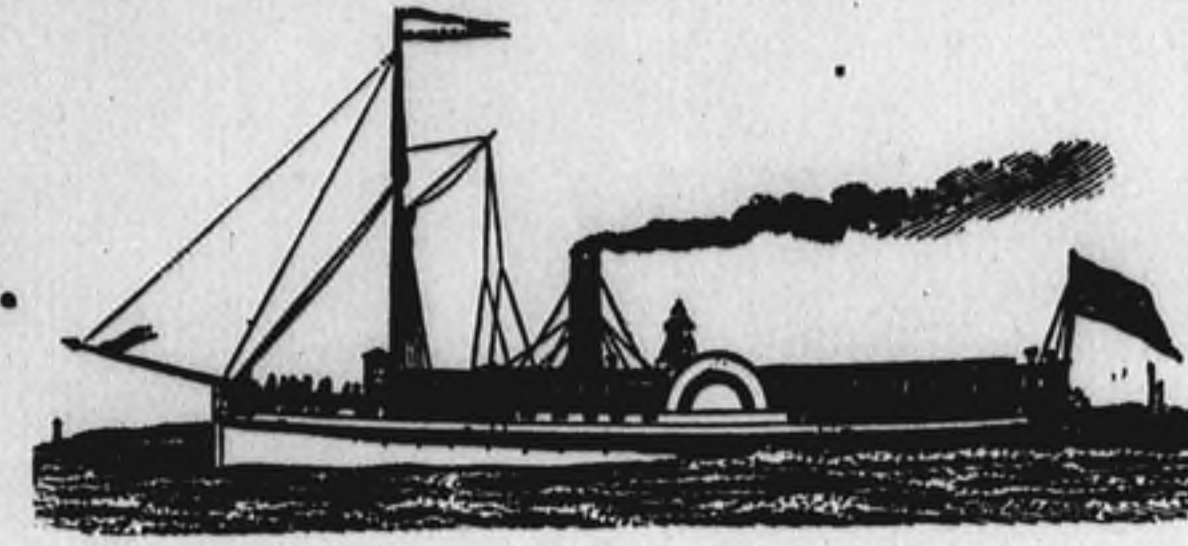

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850. and Act of May 6. 1864

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Patawica N.Y. and owns one third, and that Sheldon Tease resides at Buffalo and owns one third, and that Henry A. Richmond and J. M. Richmond reside at Buffalo, and under the firm of J. M. Richmond & Co own the remaining one third, and that they all are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller Idaho of Buffalo whereof A. B. Conkey

is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland is a State of Ohio in the year 1863, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated June 15. 1862 and numbered 126 now surrendered having been remeasured.

And Ira Barnard Jr. surveyor having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has two deck and one mast and that her length is 220 ⁷/₁₀ feet inches her breadth 32 feet inches her depth 12 ³⁷/₁₀₀ feet inches and that she measures Eleven Hundreds and ten tons 97/100 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a round stern and plaine head.

And the said Dean Richmond having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
