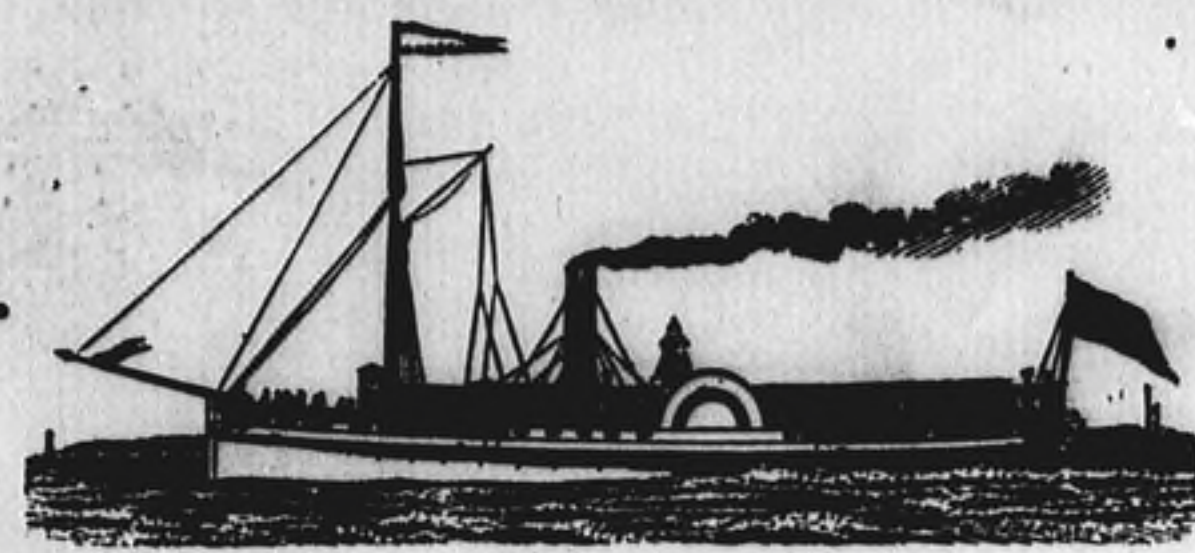

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850. and Act of May 6. 1864

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Barque Chenango of Buffalo whereof W. H. Jones

is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1862 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port dated April 11. 1865 and numbered 18 now surrendered, having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 138 feet inches her breadth 26 1/2 feet inches her depth 11 1/2 feet inches and that she measures Three Hundred and six tons 7/100 ninety fths that she is a Barque has a square stern and plain head.

And the said Henry C. Winslow having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
