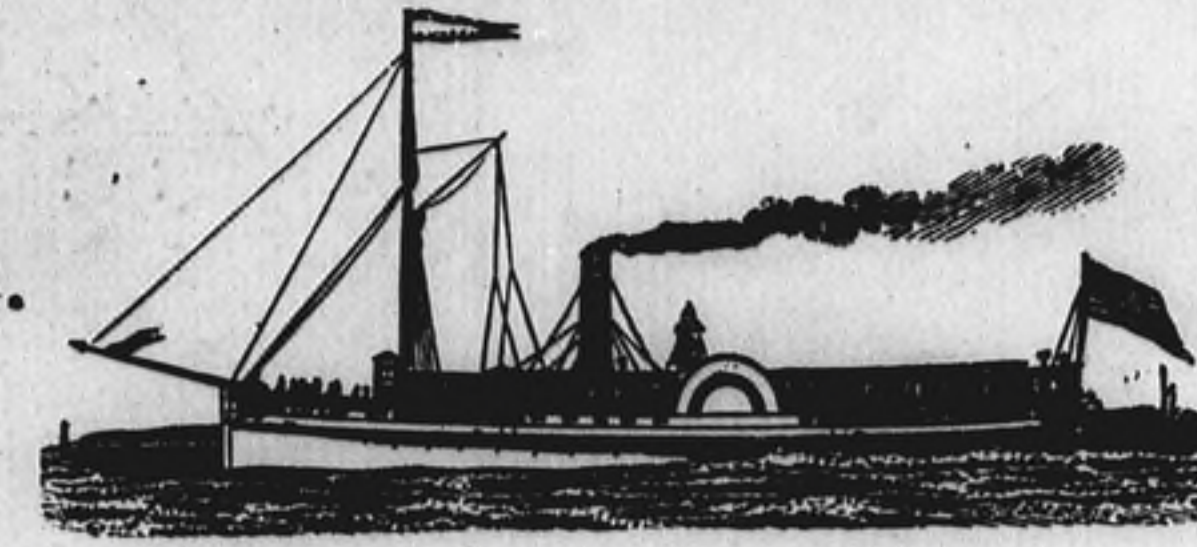

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Convoysances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850. and Act of May 6. 1864

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Madison Dock*
State of *Ohio* in the year 1856 as appears by *the Certificate of her last*
Enrollment at this Port, dated July 24 1863 and numbered 151
now surrendered having been remeasured

And *Sanford Halbert* surveyor having certified that
the said *Schooner* or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that
her length is *81 1/2* feet _____ inches
her breadth *19 4/10* feet _____ inches
her depth *7 4/10* feet _____ inches
and that she measures *Eighty five* tons *87 1/2* _____ ninety-fifths
that she is a *Schooner* has a *square* stern
and *scull* head.

And the said *Fredericke Straps* having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the
said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
