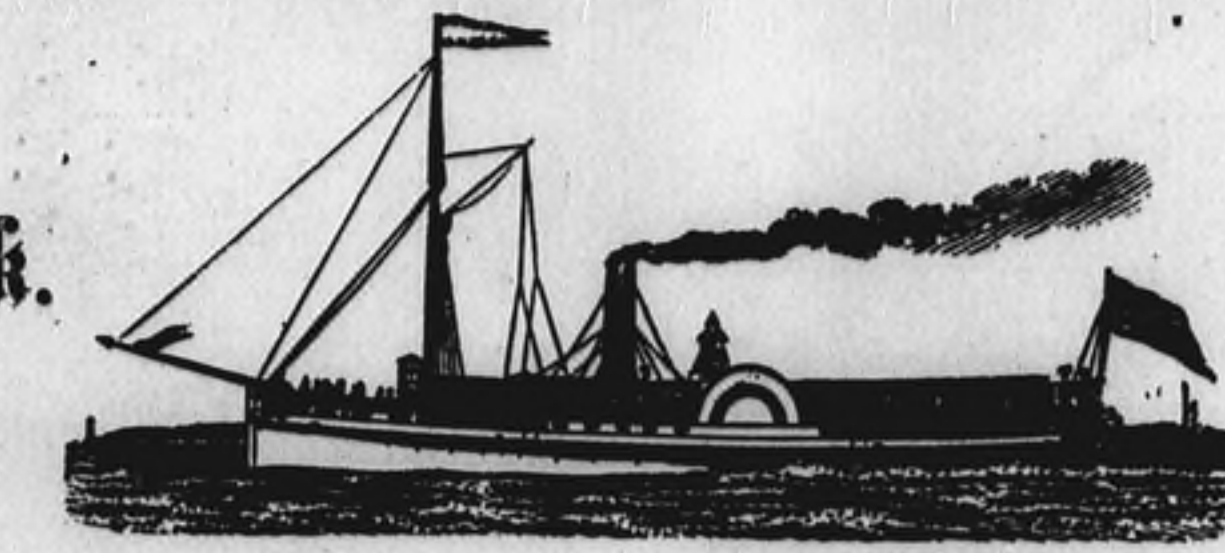

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850. and Act of May 6, 1864

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that she resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that she is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat *Tiger* of Buffalo whereof she

is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her Temp. Enrollment at the Port of Erie dated May 29, 1862 and numbered 28 now surrendered, having arrived at home port.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has no deck and no mast and that her length is 92 feet 7 1/2 inches her breadth 15 feet 6 inches her depth 8 feet and that she measures One Hundred and fourteen tons 5/100 ninety-nine and that she is a Canal Boat has a square stern and plain head.

And the said Mary A. Viele having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
