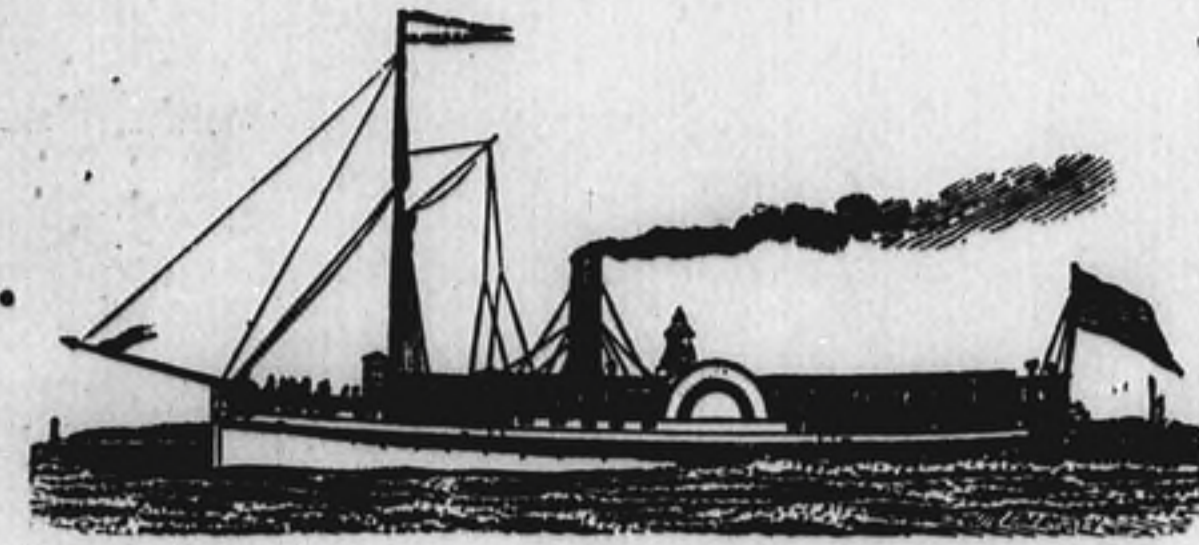

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850. and Act of May 6, 1864

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Milan, Ohio, and that J. W. Pierce resides at Vermillion Ohio and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Barque John P. March of Vermillion whereof he

is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Vermillion State of Ohio in the year 1864 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Sandusky, dated August 22, 1864 and numbered 35, now surrendered, License having expired, while from home port.

And J. Y. Cutler surveyor at Chicago having certified that the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 145 feet 60/100 inches her breadth 29 feet 70/100 inches her depth 11 feet 70/100 inches and that she measures Three Hundred and fifty five tons 87/100 ninety-fifths that she is a Barque has a square stern and plaine head.

And the said W. Wadsworth having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
