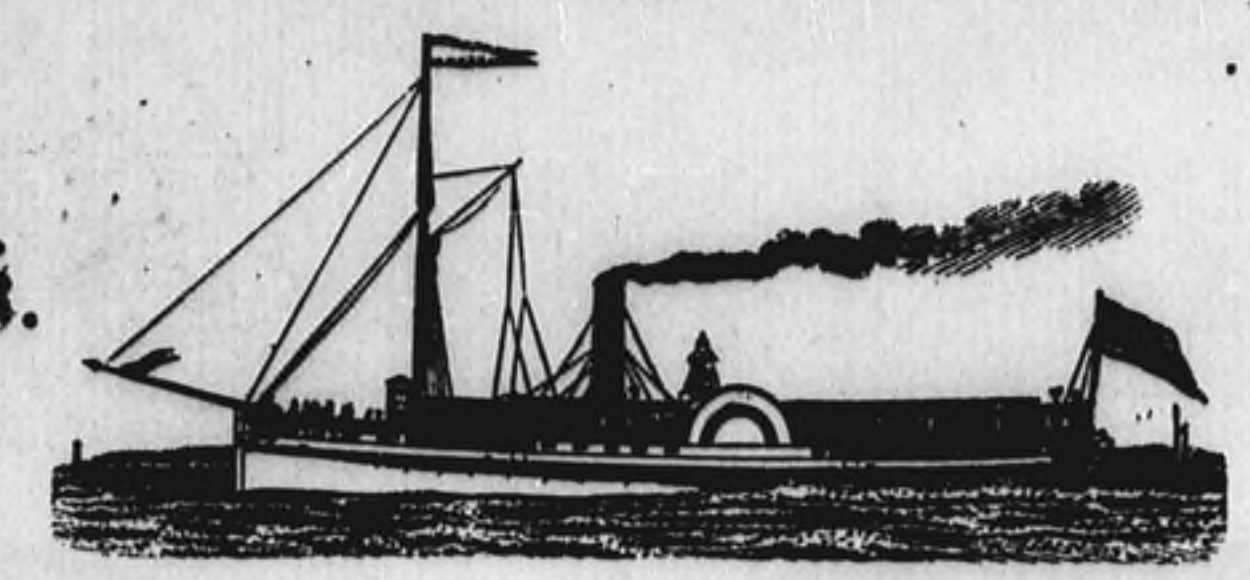

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850. and Act of May 6 1864

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Sug Propeller American Eagle* of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1865, as appears by the Certificate of Rott Scott Shipwright, her builder, on file in this Office dated Aug 24, 1865,

And Sanford Galbest having certified that the said *Sug Propeller* or vessel has one mast and that her length is 87 7/8 feet inches her breadth 16 1/2 feet inches her depth 7 1/2 feet inches and that she measures Forty Six tons 64/100 ninety fiftis that she is a *Sug Propeller* has a round stern and no figure head.

And the said Thomas Clark having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Sug Propeller* has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
