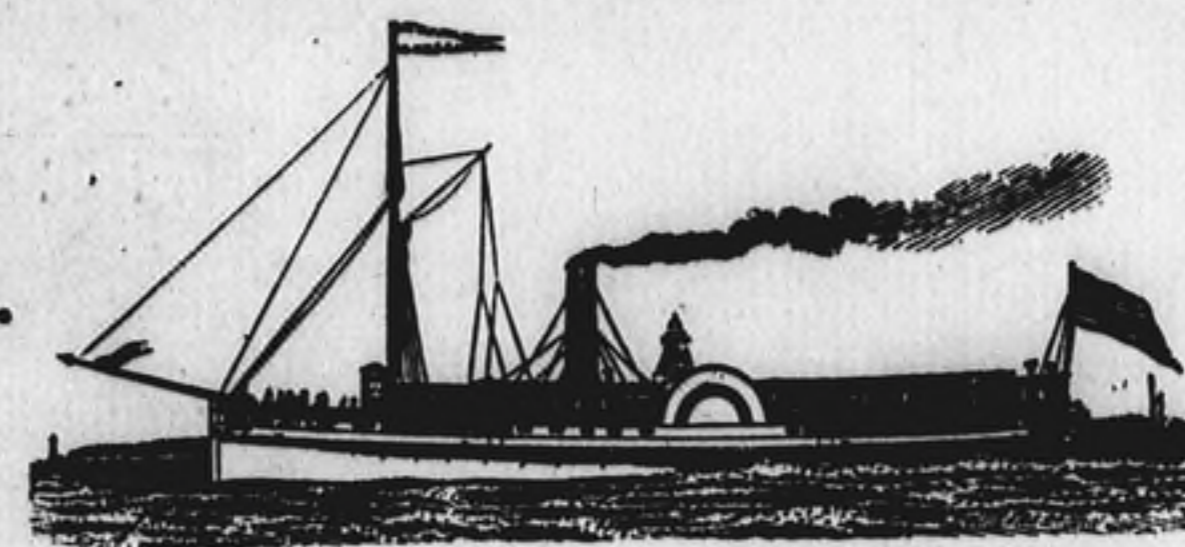

# ENROLLMENT.

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850. *and Act of May 6, 1864.*

*Thomas Baxter*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N.Y. and*  
*owns two thirds (2/3) and that Thomas W. Brown resides at the*  
*same place and owns the remaining one third (1/3) and that they*

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *Minnie Williams* of  
*Buffalo* whereof *Ramsay B. Brown* is at present Master; and as he has sworn  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Hallaeburgh*  
State of *Canada West* in the year *1863*; as appears by *the Certificate of her last*  
*Enrollment at this Port dated May 3, 1865. and numbered*  
*110 now surrendered having changed owners*

And said Enrollment having certified that  
the said Schooner or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that  
her length is *132 45/100* feet ~~inches~~  
her breadth *26 10/100* feet ~~inches~~  
her depth *12 20/100* feet ~~inches~~  
and that she measures *Two Hundred and eighty eight* tons *80/100* ~~ninety six~~  
that she is a *Schooner* has a *square* stern  
and *plain* head.

And the said *Thomas Baxter* having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the  
said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
