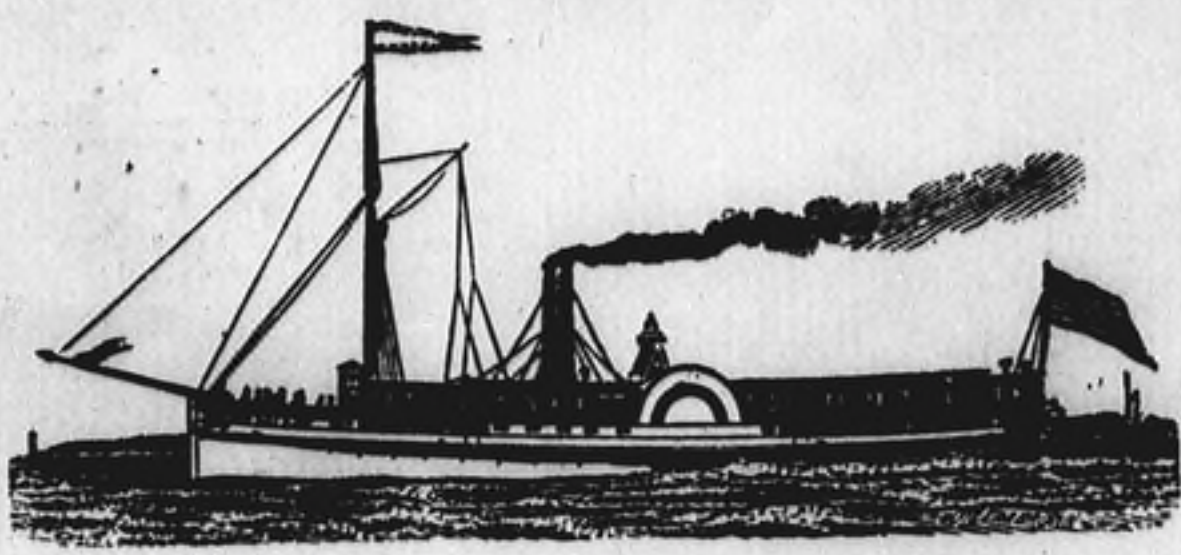

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1807, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1809, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1850, passed the 17th June 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July 1838, 29th July 1850, and 6th May 1864

John L. Jewett
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that Augustus C. Taylor resides at the same place, and that they are

each one-half
Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Barque or Vessel called the Jesse Hoyt of Buffalo whereof Alexander Love is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Barque or Vessel was built at Saginaw State of Michigan in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated August 4 1862, and numbered 120, now surrendered, having been remeasured

And J. L. Manchette, surveyor at Chicago having certified that the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 146 ¹⁵/₁₀₀ feet inches Capacity under tonnage deck 306.62 her breadth 29 ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ feet inches Capacity of enclosures on upper deck 30.36 her depth 11 feet inches 336.98 and that she measures 336 tons 98 hundredths and that she is a Barque has a square stern and a figure head.

And the said John L. Jewett having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
