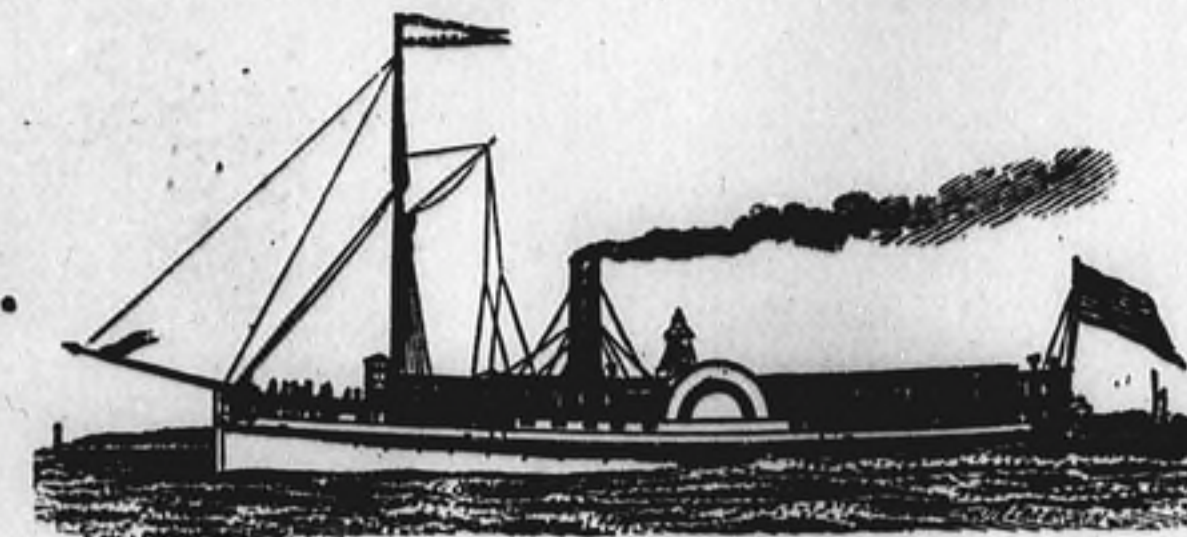

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 21, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1850. the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

John H. Belcher having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat or vessel called the Asa Lovell of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Oneida Lake N.Y. in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of Wm. McManathan shipwright, her builder, on file in this Office, dated Aug 19. 1862

And Sanford Halbert Surveyor having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 94 5/10 feet Capacity under tonnage deck 107.50 her breadth 17 5/10 feet Capacity of enclosures on upper deck 21.14 her depth 8 3/10 feet 109 tons 64 hundredths and that she is a Canal Boat has a square stern and no figure head.

And the said John H. Belcher having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
