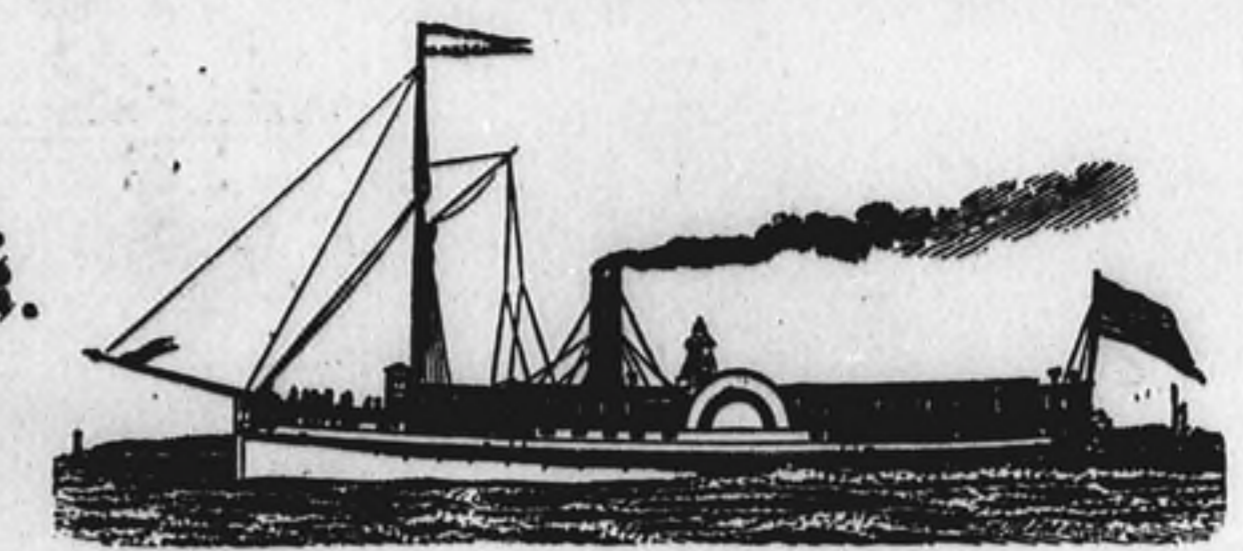

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1851, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 4th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1859, the 17th June 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Bataria N.Y.* and owns three fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$), and that *Sheldon Pease* resides at *Buffalo N.Y.* and owns one fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) and that they are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller or vessel called the *Fountain City* of *Buffalo* whereof *William H. Round* is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Propeller or Vessel was built at *Cleveland, Ohio* in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated September 15, 1863 and numbered 172, now surrendered, having been remeasured.

And *Ira Barnard, Jr.* surveyor having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has two decks and no mast and that her length is 210 feet inches Capacity under tonnage deck 569.62 her breadth 30 $\frac{7}{8}$ feet inches Capacity between decks above tonnage deck 399.86 her depth 12 feet inches 969.48 and that she measures 969 tons 48 hundredths ninety-sixths that she is a Propeller has a round stern and no figure head.

And the said *Dean Richmond* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
