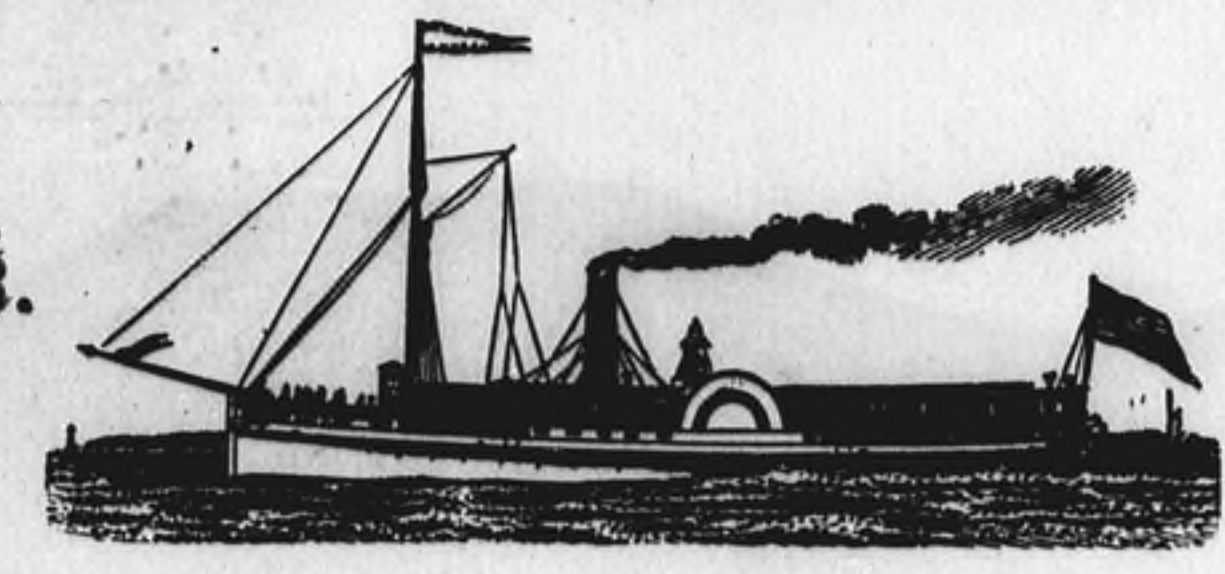

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1801, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, the 17th June 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864;

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and is Secretary of the Buffalo and Toledo Transportation Company, a corporation organized and doing business under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of New York, located at Buffalo, and that said Company is the true and

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller or vessel called the Araxes of Buffalo whereof George Williams is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo N.Y. State of in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated July 12, 1859 and numbered 60, now surrendered, having been remeasured

And Sanford Halbert surveyor having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has two decks and one mast and that her length is 182 feet — inches Capacity under tonnage deck 380.79 her breadth 30 1/10 feet — inches Capacity between decks above tonnage deck 334.21 her depth 10 1/10 feet — inches 715 — ninety-fifths and that she measures 715 tons — that she is a Propeller has a round stern and no figure head.

And the said Thomas D. Dole having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
