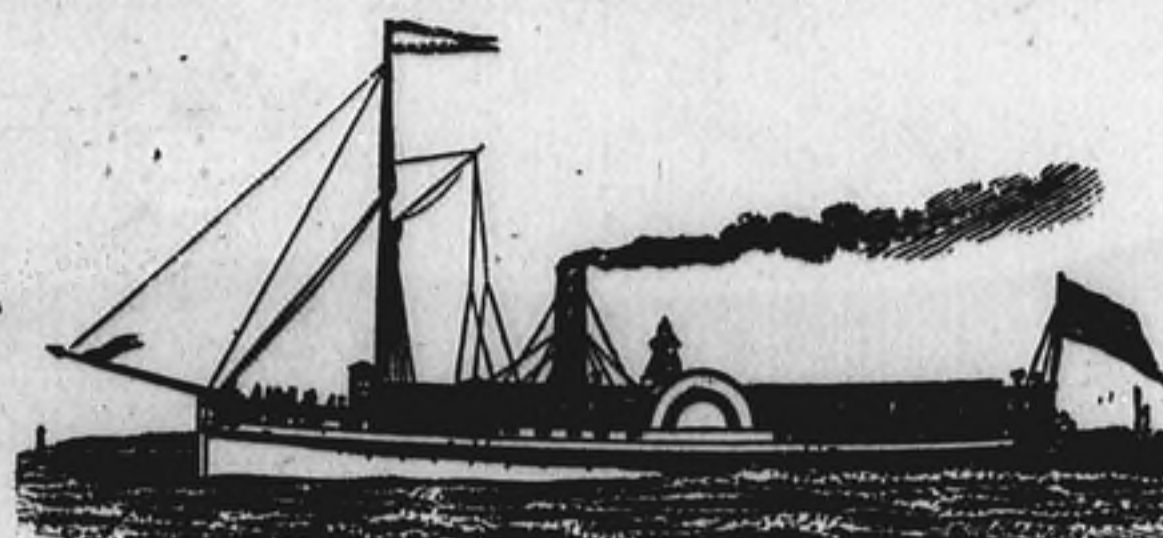

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Convoiances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1850, the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the Ellington of Buffalo whereof William J. Coleman

is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or Vessel was built at Vermillion Ohio, State of in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated Augst 28, 1865 and numbered 312, now surrendered having changed Owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 101 7/10 feet inches her breadth 22 6/10 feet inches her depth 8 4/10 feet inches and that she measures 136 tons 95 hundredths ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a scroll head.

And the said John H. Montgomery having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
