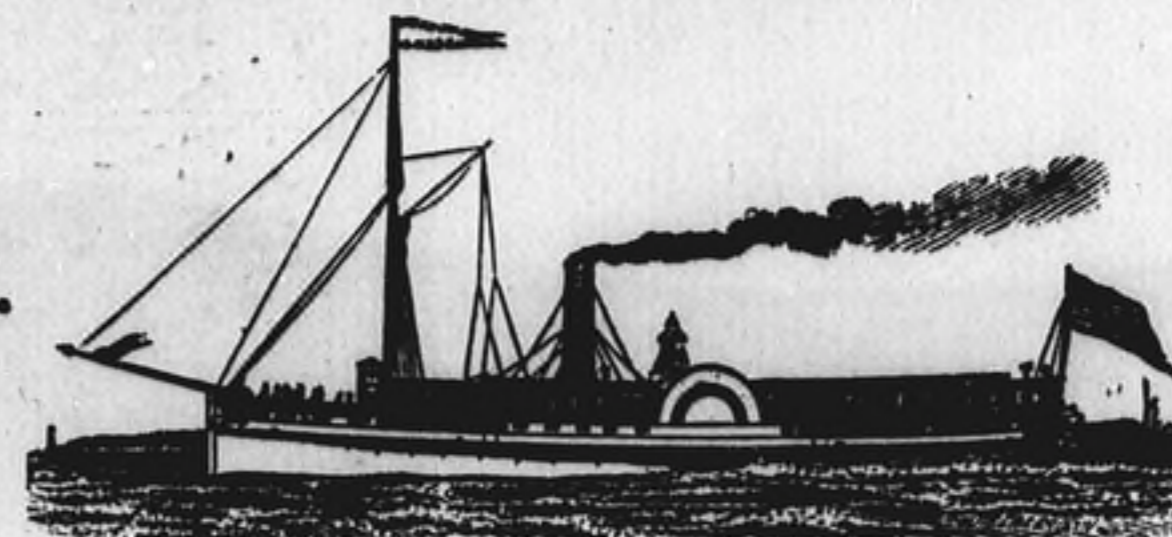

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1801, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1850, the 17th June 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and owns one quarter (1/4) and that Jesse Hoyt resides at the City of New York and owns one half (1/2) and that Charles Clark of New Jersey owns the remaining one quarter (1/4), and that they all are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Barque or Vessel called the *Winona* of Buffalo whereof William Blyden is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Barque or Vessel was built at East Saginaw, Mich in the year 1863, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated October 8. 1863, and numbered 185, now surrendered having been remeasured

And Saml W. Soule, Surveyor at Milwaukee, having certified that
