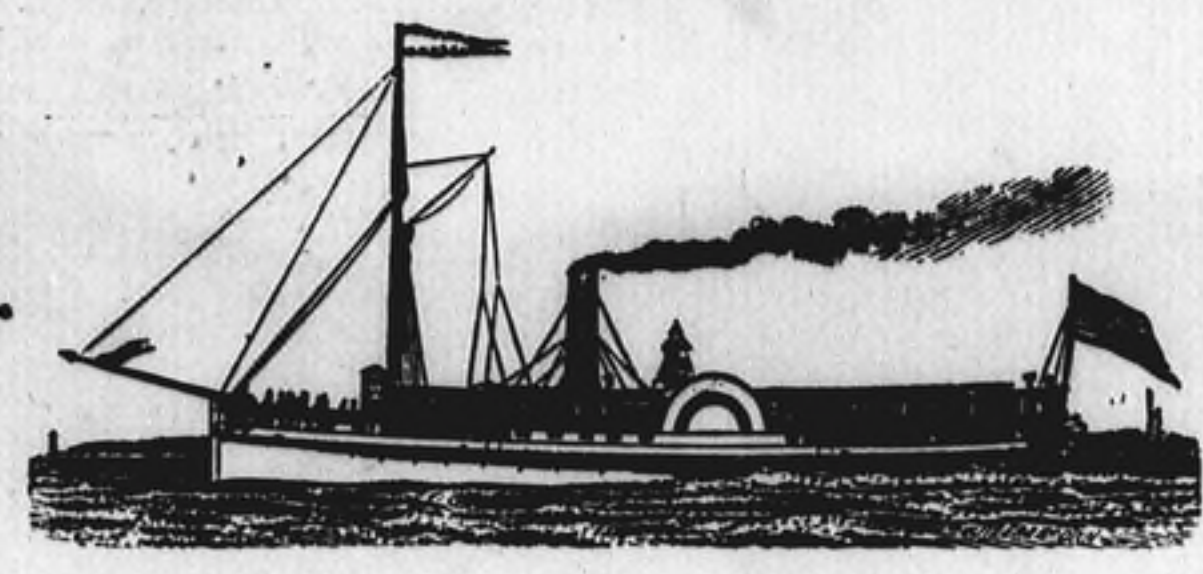

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 21, 1821, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1850, the 27<sup>th</sup> June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7<sup>th</sup> July, 1838, 29<sup>th</sup> July, 1850, and 6<sup>th</sup> May, 1864,

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the G.D. Downman of Buffalo whereof J. S. Peterson is at present Master; and as he has sworn Schooner is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio, State of in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Enrollment at the Port of Erie, dated April 25, 1865 and numbered 18, now surrendered having arrived at her home port

And Said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 136 <sup>60</sup>/<sub>100</sub> feet inches her breadth 25 <sup>88</sup>/<sub>100</sub> feet inches her depth 11 <sup>15</sup>/<sub>100</sub> feet inches and that she measures 276 tons 46 hundredths ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a plain head.

And the said Henry C Winslow having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
