

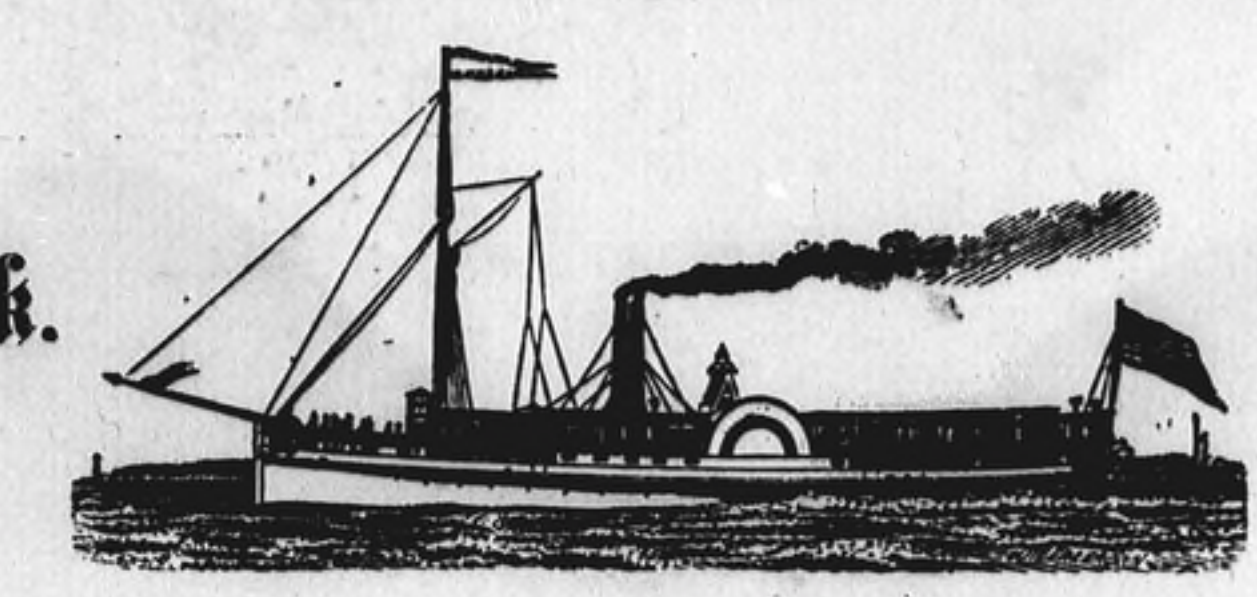

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 21, 1821, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam" passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes" passed July 20th, 1850, ~~the 17th June 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July 1850, and 6th May 1864.~~

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Lainesville Ohio, and that Henry A Harbeck resides at Cleveland Ohio, and that they are

each one half
Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the Zephyr of Cleveland whereof W. H. Duncan is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or Vessel was built at Detroit Mich. in the year 1857 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Cleveland, dated July 20. 1863 and numbered 76, now surrendered, license having expired while from home port.

And Henry A Johnson surveyor at Cleveland having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 99 7/10 feet inches Capacity under tonnage decks 136.57 her breadth is 23 3/10 feet inches Capacity of enclosures on upper decks 7 her depth is 9 feet inches 143 tons 57 hundredths ninety fifths and that she measures Schooner has a square stern and scroll head.

And the said W. H. Duncan having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
