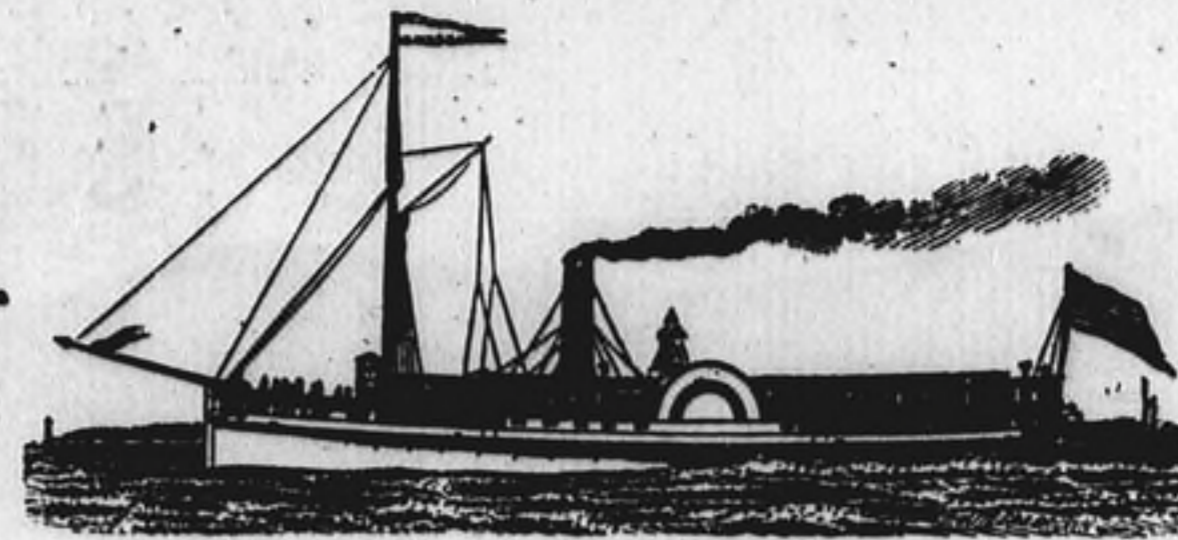

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1801, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1808, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Clearances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July 1838, 29th July 1850, and 6th May 1864.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two mast and that her length is 112 ³⁵/₁₀₀ feet inches her breadth 26 feet inches her depth 9 ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ feet inches and that she measures 179 tons 90 hundredths ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a plain head.

And the said E. Cohen having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
