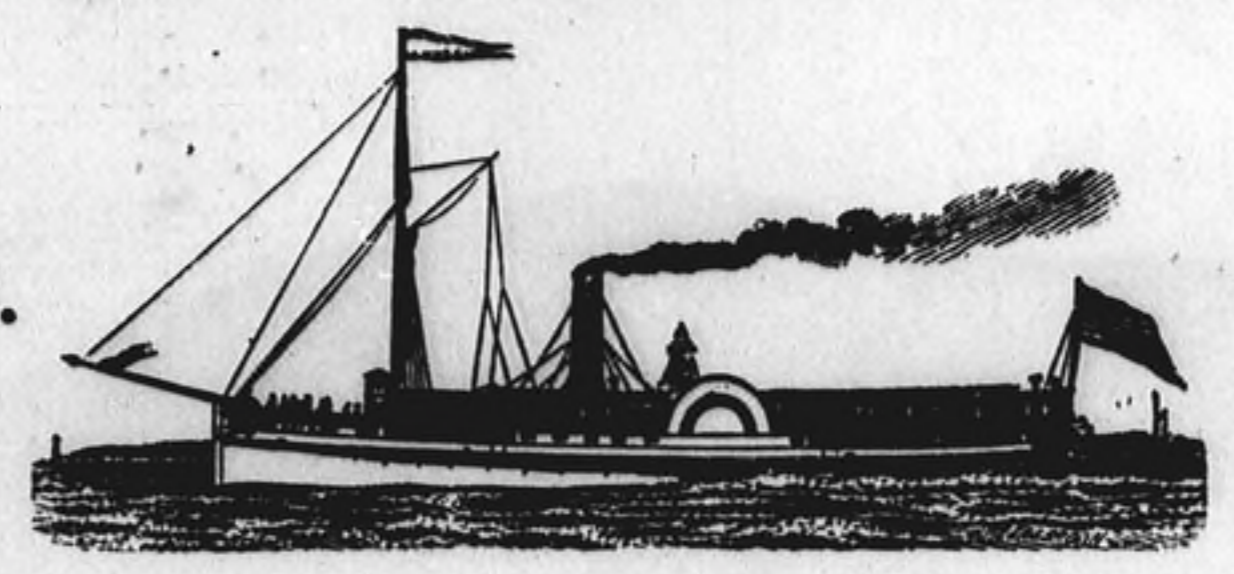

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1807, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1857, the 17 June 1864 and the acts of the 17 July 1858, 29 July 1858 and 27 May 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that John B. Williams resides at the same place and each one half owner and

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the Sweepstakes of Buffalo whereof Wm Buffington is at present Master, and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland O. State of in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Register at the Port of Chicago. Number 12 now surrendered having arrived at home port.

And said Register having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 141 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>100</sub> feet inches Capacity under tonnage deck 297 <sup>56</sup>/<sub>100</sub> her breadth 29 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>100</sub> feet inches Capacity of Enclosure on upper deck 12 <sup>28</sup>/<sub>100</sub> her depth 10 <sup>6</sup>/<sub>100</sub> feet inches Total Tonnage - 309 <sup>84</sup>/<sub>100</sub> tons 84 hundredths and that she measures 309 square feet and she is a Schooner has a square stern and Plain head.

And the said Henry C. Winslow having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
