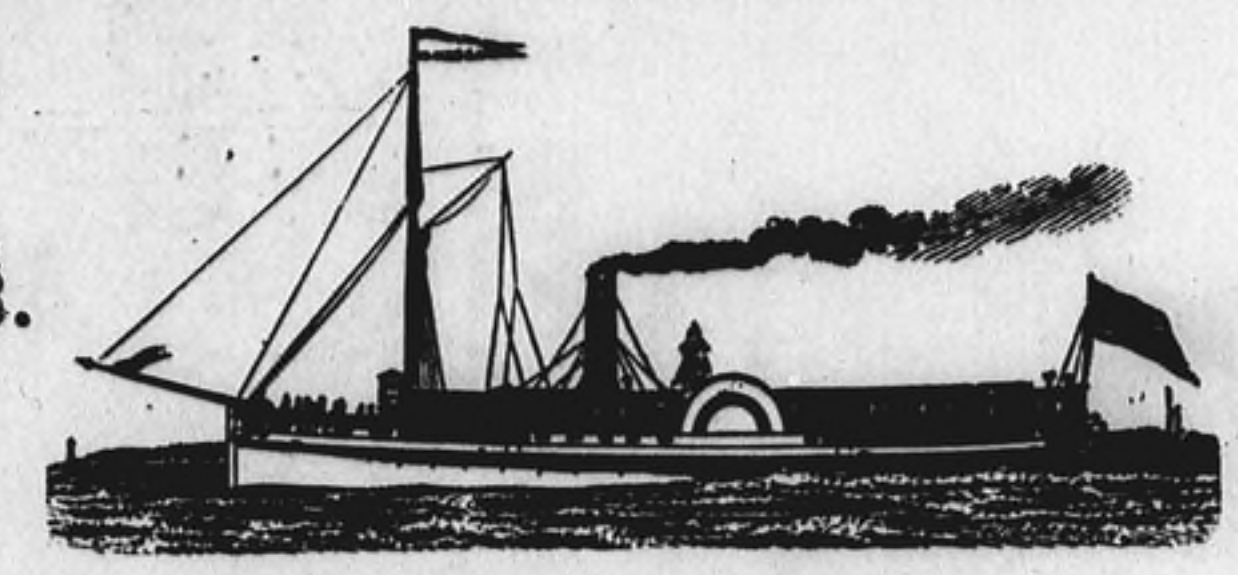




PORT OF BUFFALO

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1801, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1850, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Barque or vessel called the Geraldine of Buffalo whereof Samuel Chatterton is at present Master; and as he has sworn

that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Wilson N.Y. State of in the year 1866, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated August 30, 1867 and numbered 225, now surrendered, having been remeasured

And Inas Barnard Jr surveyor having certified that the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 123 2/4 feet inches her breadth 25 7/10 feet inches her depth 10 7/10 feet inches

and that she measures 223 tons & 93 hundredths ninety-ninth that she is a Barque has a square stern and no figure head.

And the said Henry A Richmond having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
