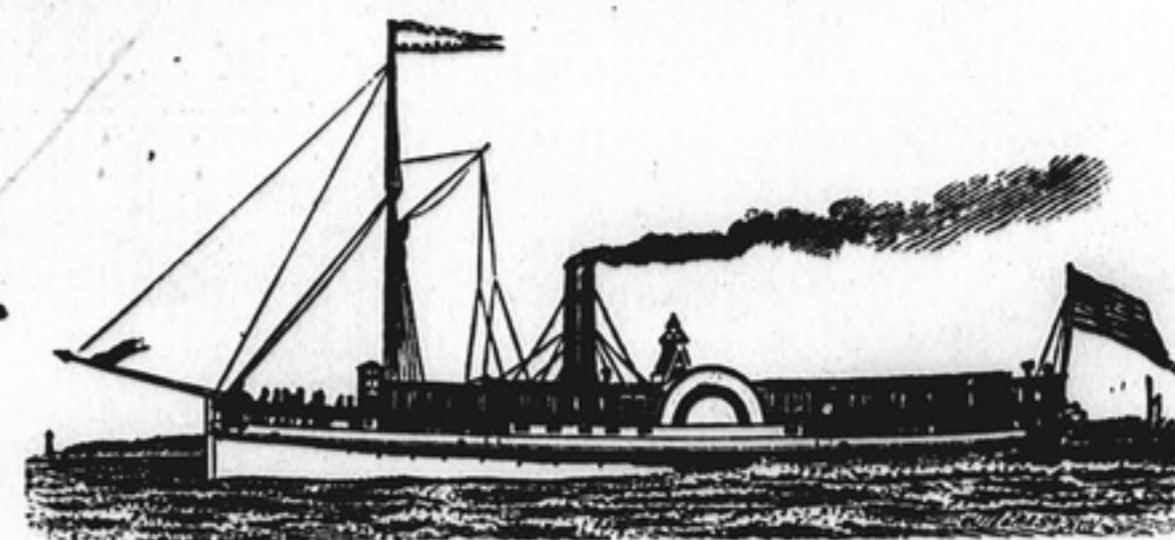

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Canal Boat* or vessel called *the Eastern of Buffalo* whereof *he* is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said *Canal Boat* or Vessel was built at *Lockport N.Y.* in the year 1857, as appears by *the Certificate of H. F. Bailey* Shipwright, her builder, on file in this Office

And <i>Sanford Halbert</i> , Surveyor	having certified that
the said <i>Canal Boat</i> or vessel has	<i>one</i> deck and <i>no</i> mast and that
her length is <i>95 ³/₁₀</i> feet	<i>Capacity under tonnage deck</i> <i>77.74</i>
her breadth is <i>16 ⁶/₁₀</i> feet	<i>Head Room</i> <i>2.07</i>
her depth is <i>6 ²/₁₁</i> feet	<i>79 tons & 81/100</i> <i>ninety-fifths</i>

and that she measures *Canal Boat* has a *square* stern and *no* head.

And the said *Nevim Nugent* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Canal Boat* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
