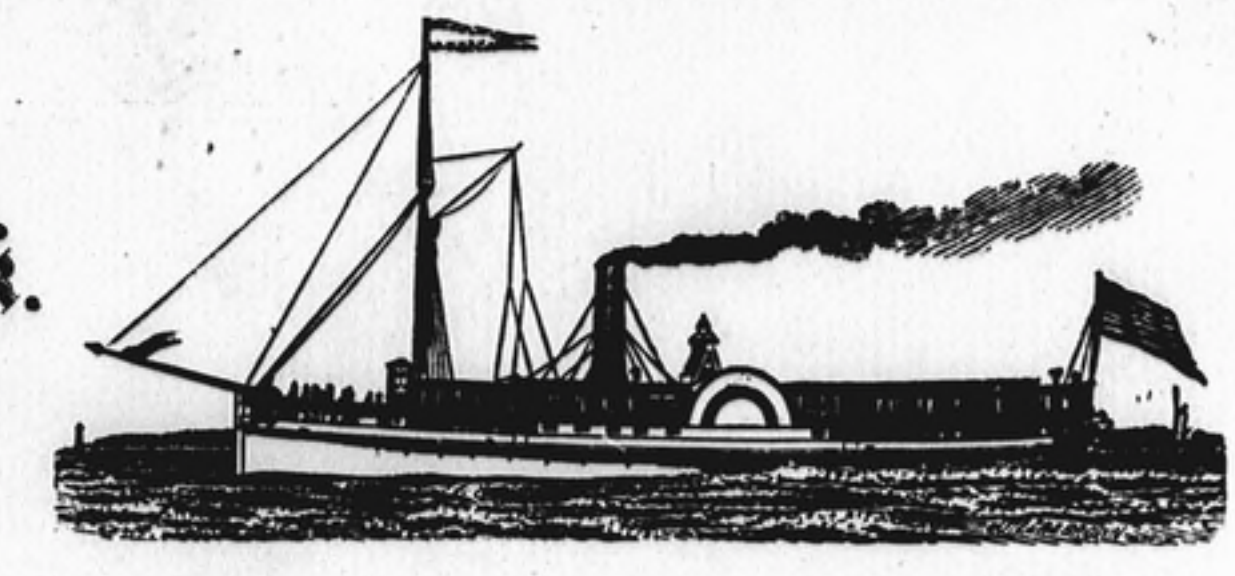

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 21, 1821, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1850, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Convoys of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1850, the 17th June 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 20th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and owns five twelfths ($\frac{5}{12}$), that Lawrence Weber resides at the same place, and owns four twelfths ($\frac{4}{12}$), and that Daniel Rogers resides at the same place and owns the remaining three twelfths ($\frac{3}{12}$) and that they all are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the Africa of Buffalo whereof Daniel Rogers is at present Master; and as he has sworn Schooner is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Vermillion, Ohio, State of in the year 1855, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated Sept 20, 1865, and numbered 350, now surrendered, having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 113 $\frac{8}{10}$ feet inches Capacity under tonnage deck 176.86 her breadth 24 feet inches Capacity of enclosures on upper deck 8.69 her depth 10 $\frac{3}{10}$ feet inches 185 tons & 55 hundredths ninety-fifths and that she measures 185 tons & 55 hundredths ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and scroll figure head.

And the said Allen Wardwell having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
