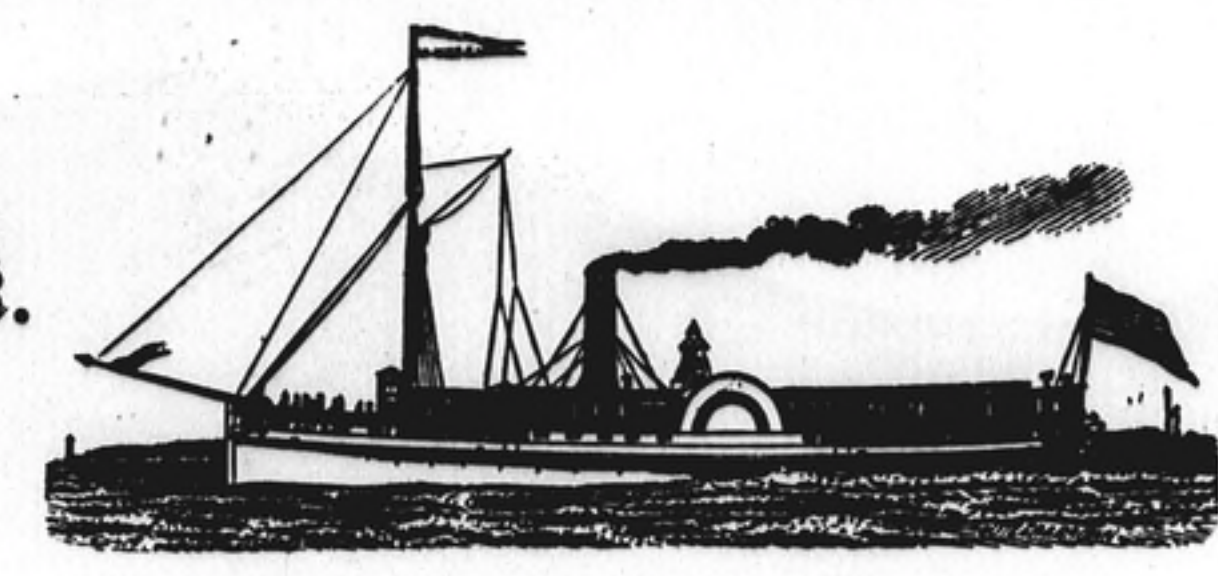

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1801; and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 5th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1850, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1850, the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Erie Pa, and that Herman S. Stearns and Abraham J. Louch, reside at the same place and that they all are

each one third of
Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the Alameda of Buffalo whereof A. J. Louch is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or Vessel was built at St Joseph, Mich. in the year 1845, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 25, 1865, and numbered 57, now surrendered, having changed Owners to District

Buffalo, May 2, 1869
Surrendered and new Papers issued, having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 123 feet inches Capacity under tonnage deck 200.39 her breadth is 25 2/10 feet inches Capacity of enclosures on upper deck 13.79 her depth is 9 5/10 feet inches 214 tons and 15/100 ninety-fifths and that she measures 214 tons and 15/100 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square stern and no figure head. And the said Philander S. Timm having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
