



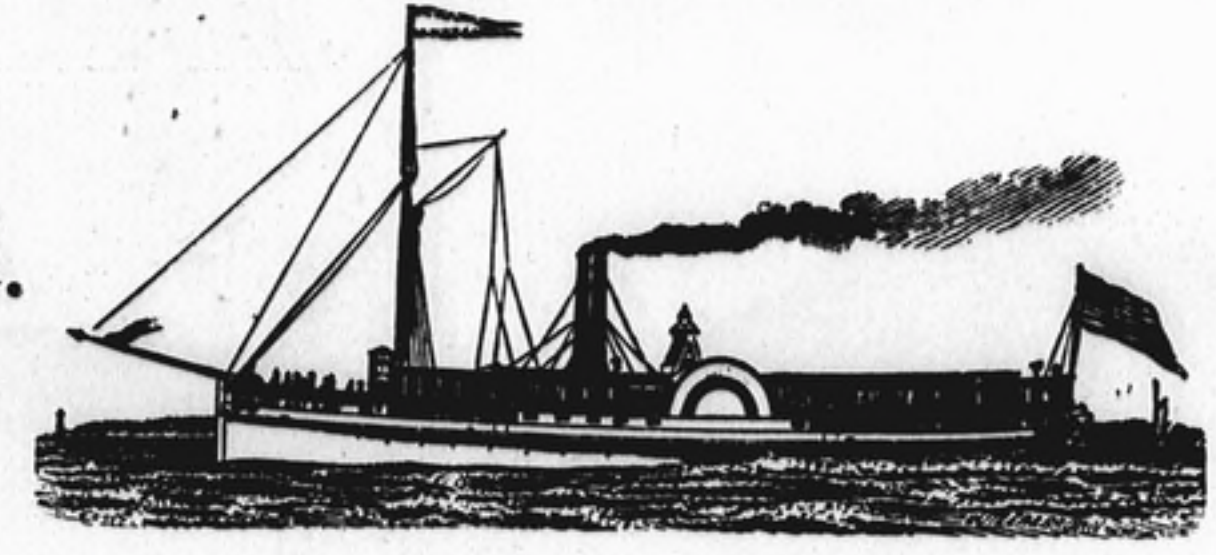

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1821, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1856. *the 17th June 1864 and the Act of the 7th July 1838 29th July 1850 and 6th May 1864*

John H. Montgomery
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N.Y.* and owns *three fourths (3/4)*, that *John McElligott* resides at *Chicago Ill.* and owns the remaining one fourth (1/4), and that they both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the *Harover* of *Buffalo* whereof *John H. Montgomery* is at present Master; and as he has sworn *Schooner* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said *Ship* or Vessel was built at *Irving N.Y.* in the year 1852, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated February 27th 1866, and numbered 11, now surrendered, having changed Owners.

And Said Enrollment having certified that the said *Schooner* or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *109 2/10* feet *inches* Capacity under tonnage decks *173.98* her breadth is *25 6/10* feet *inches* Capacity of enclosures on upper decks *14.33* her depth is *8 2/10* feet *inches* *188* tons *31 hundredths ninety-fifths* and that she measures *188* tons *round* stern that she is a *Schooner* has a *round* stern and *no figure* head. And the said *John H. Montgomery* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
