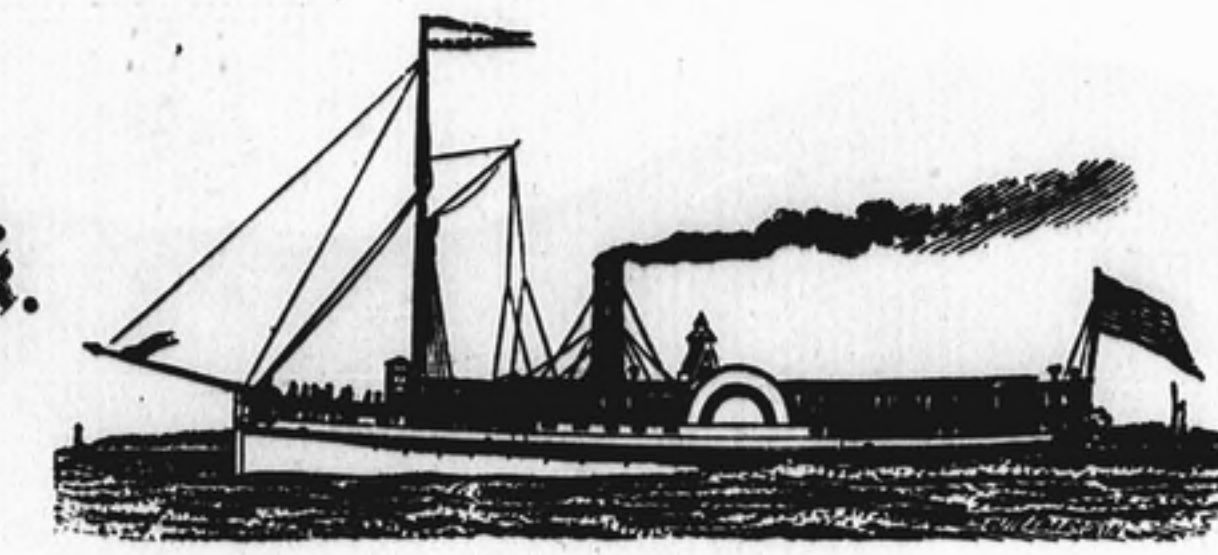

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1801, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1808, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1850, the 17th June 1864 and the act of the 7th July 1858

And Said Enrollments having certified that the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 166 ³/₁₀ feet inches Capacity under tonnage deck 434.11 her breadth 21 ²/₁₀ feet inches Capacity of envelopures on upper deck 17.59 her depth 12 ⁸/₁₀ feet inches and that she measures 451 tons & 70 hundredths ninety-fifths that she is a Barque has a square stern and female head.

And the said Charles J. Mann having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
