

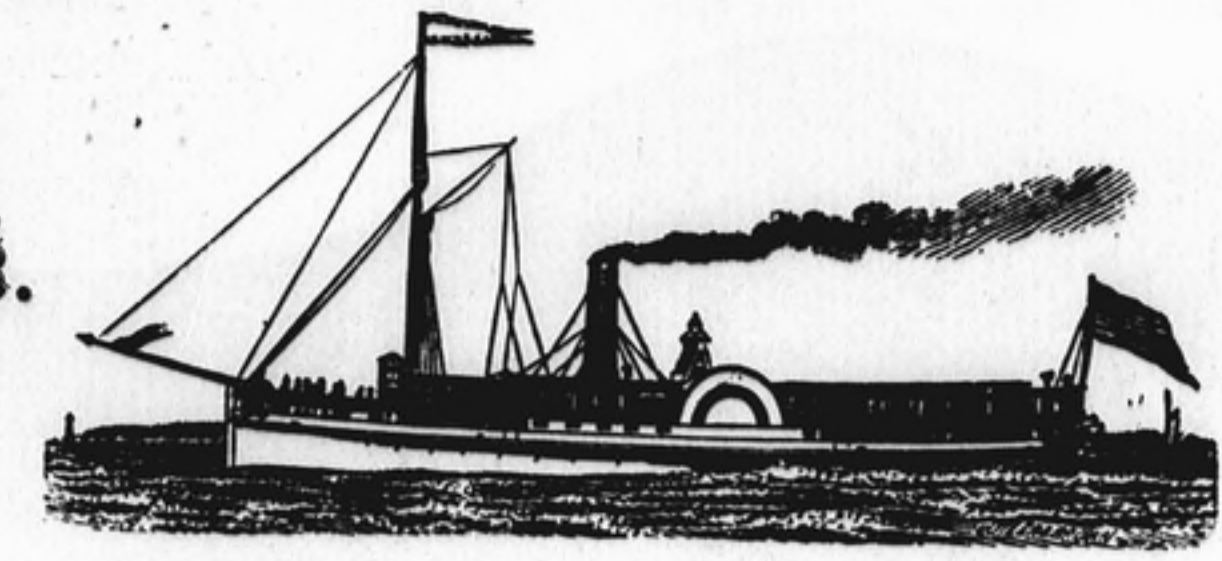

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 27, 1821, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Convoyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1850. the 17th June 1884 and the Act of the 7th July 1888 29th July 1888. 16th May 1888.
