

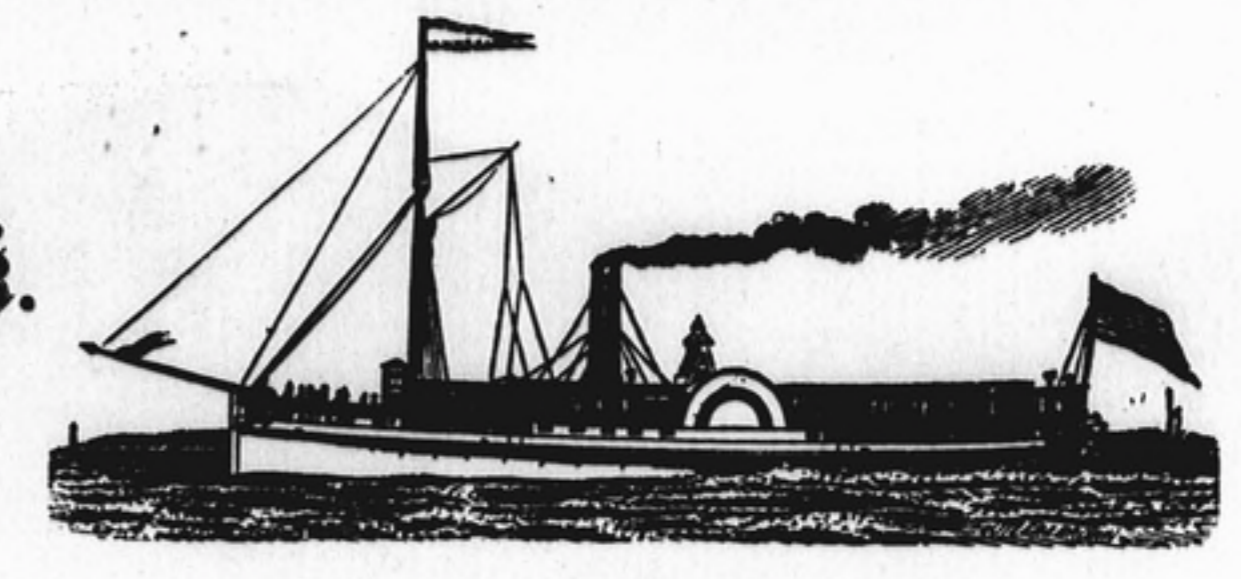

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1801, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1826, and the Act of August 26th, 1850, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 26th, 1850. the 17<sup>th</sup> June 1864 and the Act of July 7<sup>th</sup> 1838

29 July 1850 & 6<sup>th</sup> May 1864  
*Henry C Winslow*  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y., and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the *Robert Emmet* of Buffalo whereof *L. H. Byram* is at present Master; and as he has sworn Schooner is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or Vessel was built at Buffalo N.Y. in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Sandusky, dated May 11. 1865, and numbered 41, now surrendered, having changed Owners & Districts

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 114<sup>5</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet inches Capacity under tonnage deck 185.88 her breadth 25<sup>6</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet inches Capacity of enclosures on upper deck 10.14 her depth 8<sup>95</sup>/<sub>100</sub> feet inches 196.02 and that she measures 196 tons & 02 hundredths ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square stern and plain head.

And the said *Henry C. Winslow* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
