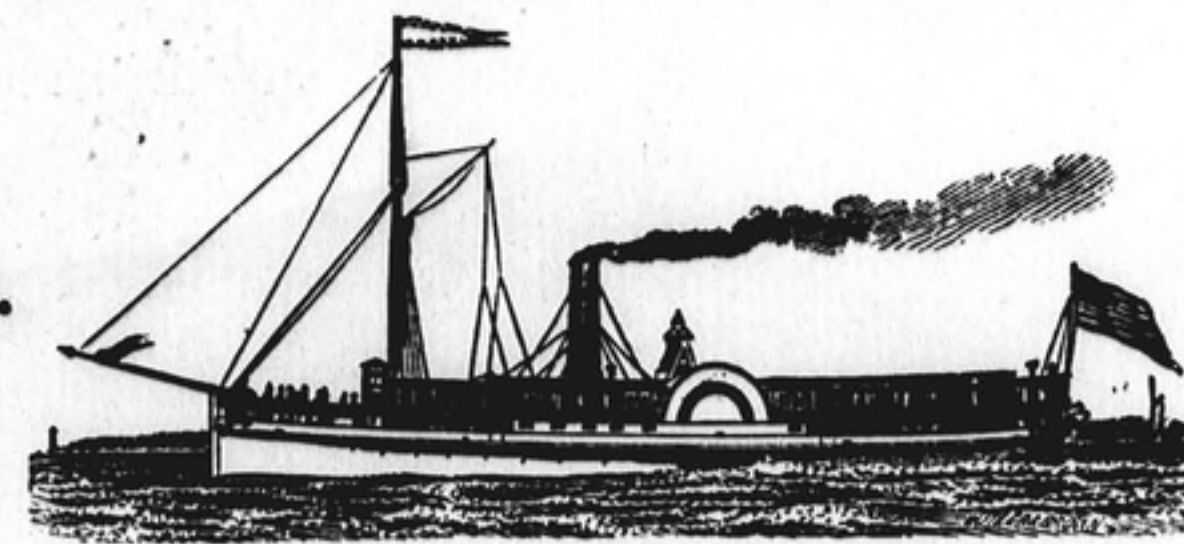

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1821, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Convoyances of Vessels; and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1850, the 17 June 1864 and the acts of the 7 July 1838 29 July 1850 and 6 May 1864.

Henry C Winslow
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y., and owns in trust for Caroline S. Williams, who resides at Buffalo N.Y., seven sixteenths (7/16), that Hezekiah J. Winslow resides at New York City and owns seven sixteenths (7/16), and that David McCormick resides at Buffalo N.Y., and owns the remaining two sixteenths (2/16) and that they are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the Tracy J. Bronson of Buffalo whereof David McCormick is at present Master; and as he has sworn Schooner is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio. State of in the year 1855, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated October 3, 1865, and numbered 367, now surrendered, having changed Owners

And Said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 137 ³⁰/₁₀₀ feet inches her breadth 26 feet inches her depth 11 ⁶⁵/₁₀₀ feet inches and that she measures 277 tons & 22 hundredths ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and plaine head.

And the said Henry C Winslow agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
