

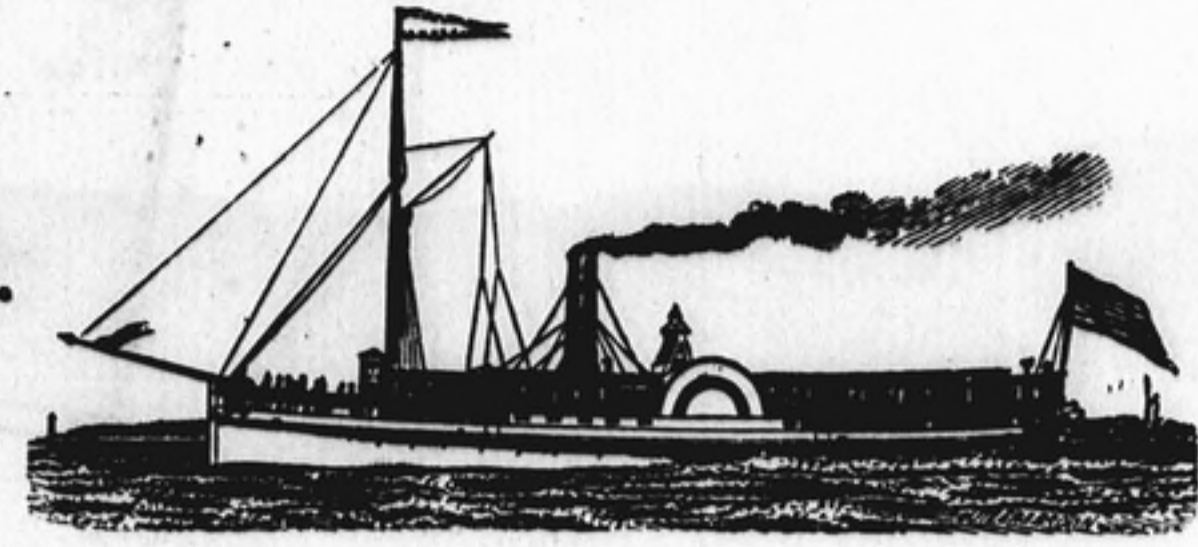

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1804, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850. 17 June 1864 and the acts of the 7th July 1858. 29 July 1850 & 6th May 1864.

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or Vessel was built at Conneaut, Ohio, in the year 1848, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated March 7. 1865, and numbered 12, now surrendered, having been remeasured.

And A H Seriven Surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 104 ⁷/₁₀ feet inches Capacity under tonnage decks 161.39 her breadth 25 ⁶/₁₀ feet inches Capacity of enclosures on upper decks 8.30 her depth 8 ⁶/₁₀ feet inches 169.69 and that she measures 169 tons & 69/100 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and scroll head.

And the said Louis Talbot having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
