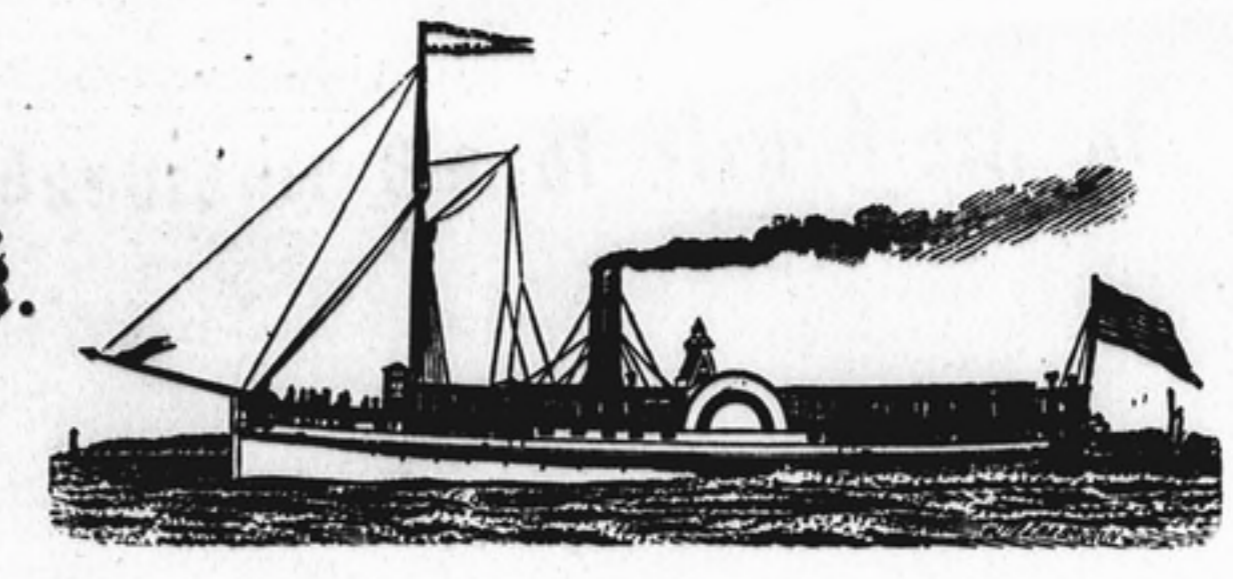

ENROLLMENT.

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 20, 1801; and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1822, and the Act of August 20th, 1850, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850. 17 June 1864 and the act of the 7 July 1838 29 July 1850 & 6 May 1864.

A. Sherwood

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that John H. Vought resides at the same place, and that they both are

under the name and firm of Sherwood & Co. Citizens of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig or vessel called the N. M. Standard of Buffalo whereof James G. Orr is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Euclid, Ohio, in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 13, 1865, and numbered 29, now surrendered, having Head Room added.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 138 ³⁰/₁₀₀ feet inches Capacity under tonnage decks 317.54 her breadth 29 ⁶⁰/₁₀₀ feet inches Capacity of enclosures on upper decks 14.42 her depth 11 ⁷⁵/₁₀₀ feet inches 331.96 and that she measures 331 tons & 96 hundredths ninety-ninths that she is a Brig has a square stern and ornamental head.

And the said A. Sherwood having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
