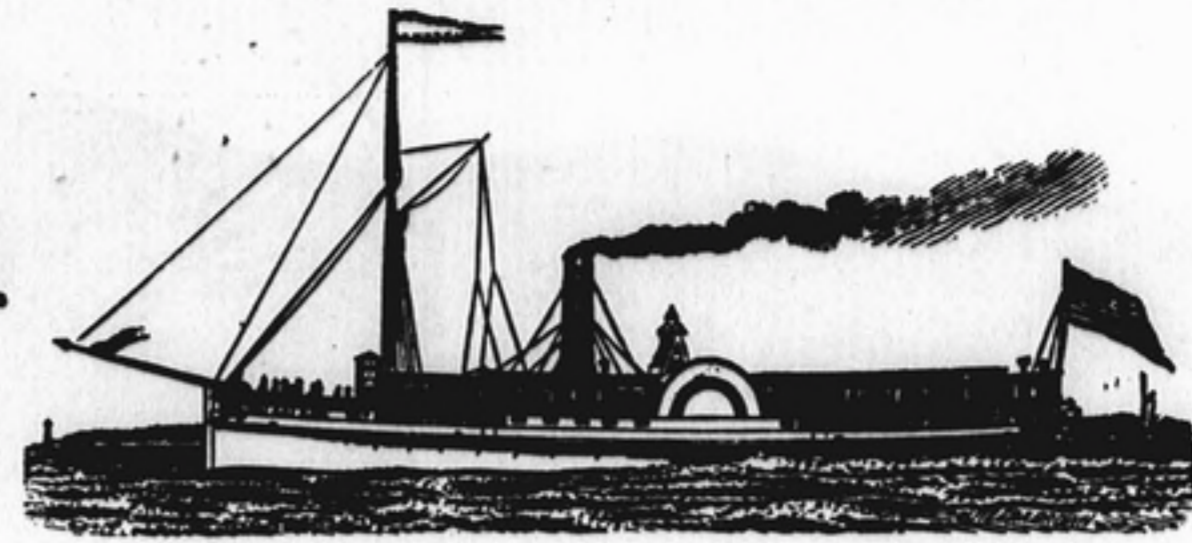

# ENROLLMENT.

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1801, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1850, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1850. *The 17 June 1864 and the acts of the 7 July 1838*

*29 July 1850 & 6 May 1864*  
*Susannah B. Loveridge*  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that she resides at *Buffalo N.Y.* and that she is a

*Custom House.  
Buffalo, October 2, 1866.  
Surrendered and new Papers issued,  
having changed Owners.*

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the *Sophia Smith*, of *Buffalo* whereof *J. W. Fritz* is at present Master; and as he has sworn Schooner is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo N.Y.* in the year *1855*, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated *April 28, 1865*, and numbered *76*, now surrendered having changed Owners

And *Said Enrollment* having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *138 <sup>4</sup>/<sub>10</sub>* feet *—* inches her breadth *26 <sup>8</sup>/<sub>10</sub>* feet *—* inches her depth *10 <sup>8</sup>/<sub>10</sub>* feet *—* inches and that she measures *259* tons *259 hundredths ninety-fifths* that she is a Schooner has a *square* stern and *no figure* head.

And the said *Susannah B. Loveridge* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
