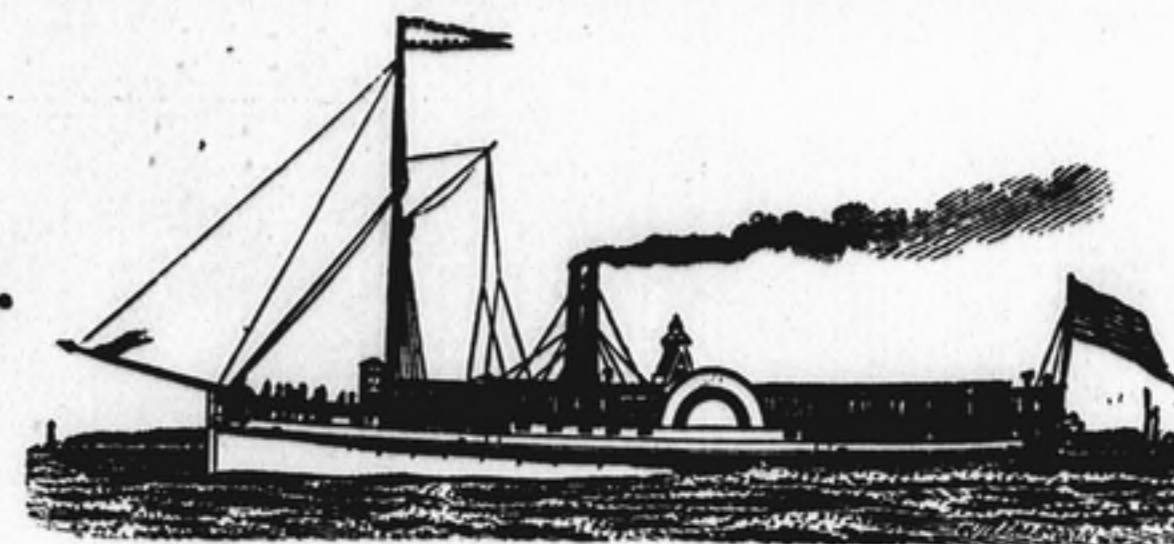

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1804; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1859.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Barque* or vessel called the *P. C. Sherman* of *Buffalo* whereof *Geo R. McCartney* is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said *Barque* or Vessel was built at *Cleveland, Ohio* in the year 1862 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated *May 13, 1865*, and numbered *25*, now surrendered, having changed Owners and having *Head Room* added.

And *A. H. Scriven* surveyor having certified that the said *Barque* or vessel has *one* deck and *three* masts and that her length is *150* feet *7/10* inches Capacity under tonnage deck *382.91* her breadth *30* feet *6/10* inches Capacity of enclosures on upper decks *23.52* her depth *12* feet *6/10* inches *406* tons *43* hundredths *406.43* and that she measures *406* tons *43* hundredths *406.43* that she is a *Barque* has a *square* stern and *figure* head.

And the said *Robert Montgomery* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Barque* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
