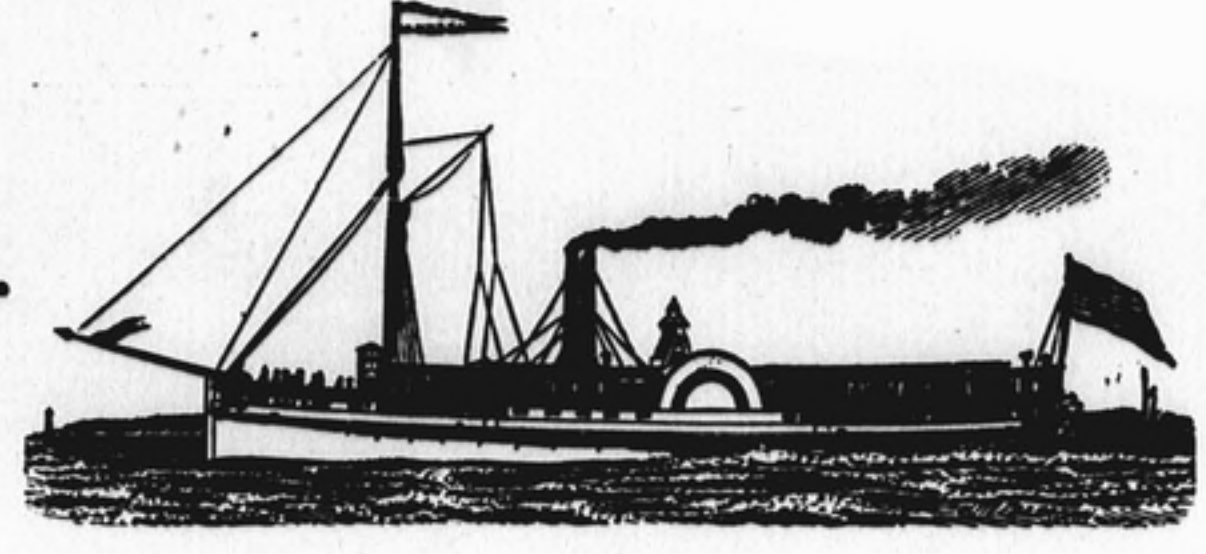

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1801, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and owns two thirds (2/3), and that John Cunningham resides at the same place, and owns one third (1/3), and that they are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the *Lively* whereof John Cunningham is at present Master; and as he has sworn Schooner is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan, Ohio, in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 22, 1865, and numbered 50, now surrendered, having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 119 ⁴/₁₀ feet inches her breadth 25 ⁴/₁₀ feet inches her depth 10 ³/₁₀ feet inches and that she measures 208 tons ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and no figure head.

And the said Char. M. Rand having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
