

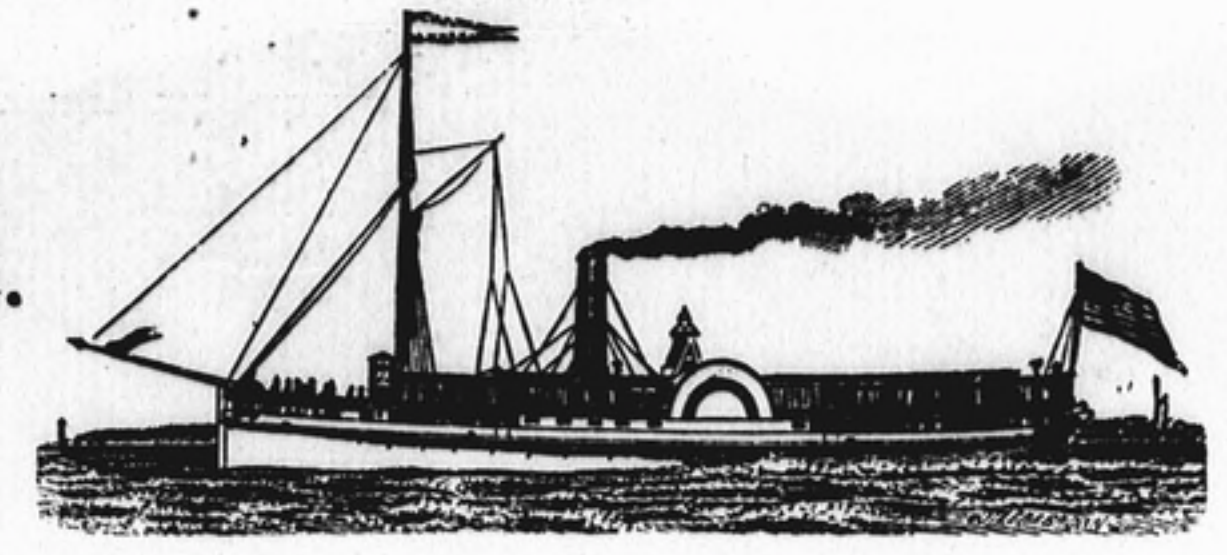

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1850. *the 17 June 1804 & the acts of the 7 July 1838*

State of *N.Y.* in the year 18 *63* as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment
at this Port, dated *April 29, 1865*, and numbered *81*, now surrendered
having Head Room added

And *Ira Burnard Jr.* surveyor having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that
her length is *129 6/10* feet *—* inches Capacity under tonnage decks *244.31*
her breadth *25 4/10* feet *—* inches Capacity of enclosures on upper deck *8.24*
her depth *10 6/10* feet *—* inches *252.55*
and that she measures *252* tons *755 hundredths ninety-fifths*
that she is a *Schooner* has a *square* stern
and *no figure* head.
