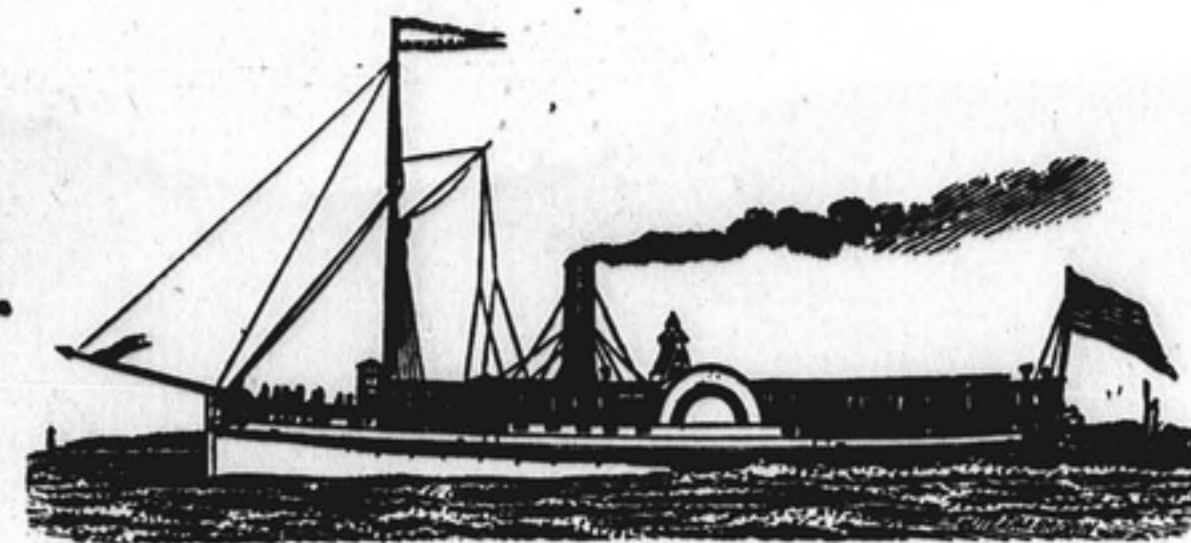

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1801, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1856, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Licensing the Commanders of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1860, the 17th June 1864 and the Acts of the 7th July 1838

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Evans N.Y.* and that *David Cook and Henry A. Cook* reside at *Hanover N.Y.* and that they all are

Lyman Cook Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the *Dreadnought* of *Buffalo* whereof *Lyman Cook* is at present Master; and as he has sworn *Lyman Cook* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or Vessel was built at *Oswego N.Y.* in the year *1856*, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated *July 6. 1856*, and numbered *255*, now surrendered, having changed Owners.

And *Lyman Cook* said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *136 7/10* feet *inches* her breadth *26* feet *inches* her depth *11 7/10* feet *inches* and that she measures *302* tons *of hundredths ninety fifth* that she is a *Schooner* has a *square* stern and *a figure* head.

And the said *Lyman Cook* agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
