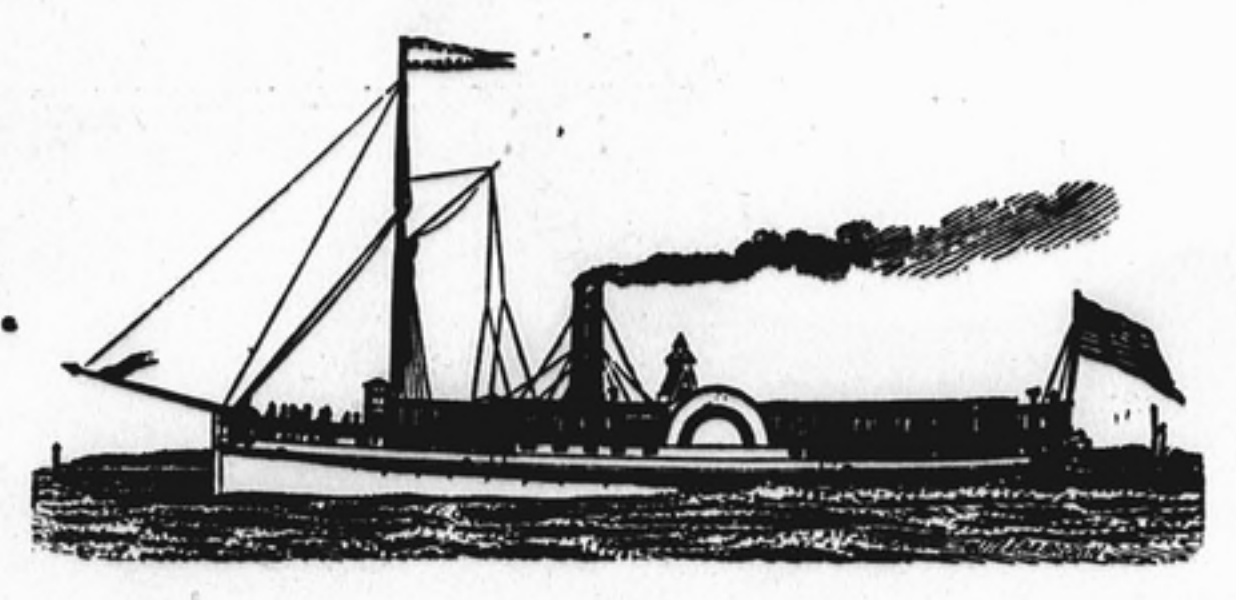

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam" passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1850, the 17th June 1864 & the acts of the 7th July 1838 - 29 July 1850 & May 1867.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Sardinia of Buffalo whereof M. Demick is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said ^{Schooner} or Vessel was built at Detroit, Mich State of Michigan in the year 1860, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 17 1865. and numbered 33. now surrendered, having Stead room added

And Jas Barnard Jr surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 140 7/10 feet — inches } Capacity under tonnage deck 311.63 her breadth 26 5/8 feet — inches } Capacity of enclosures on upper deck 12.33 her depth 12 4/10 feet — inches } 323.96 and that she measures 323 tons & 96/100 ninety fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and no figure head.
