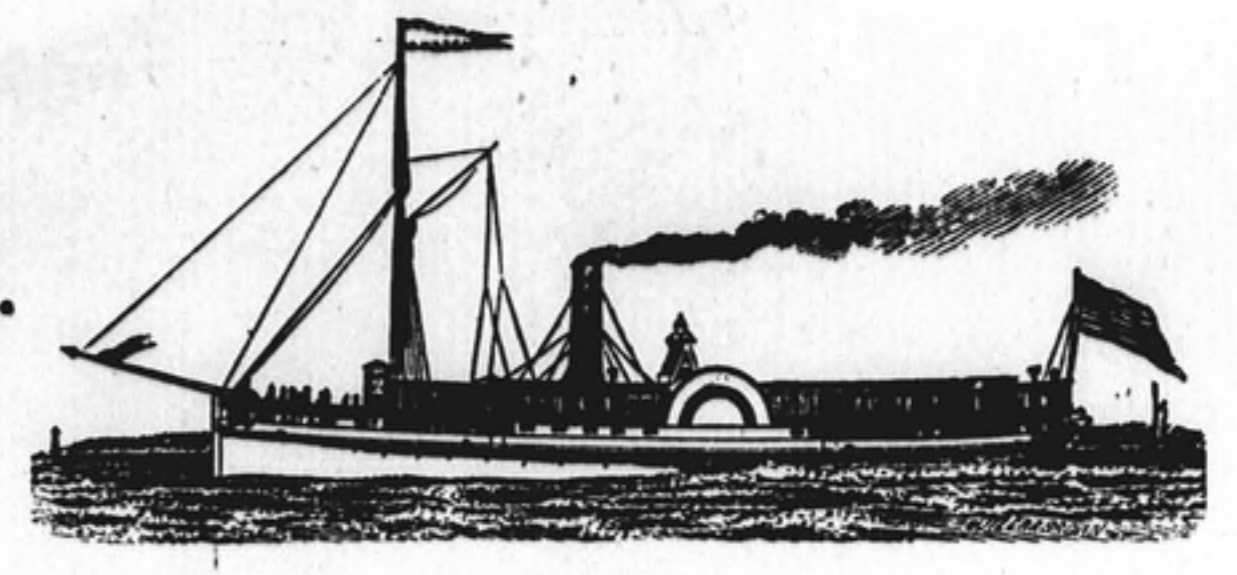

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850. the 17<sup>th</sup> June 1864 and the acts of the 7<sup>th</sup> July 1838 29<sup>th</sup> July 1850 & the 6<sup>th</sup> May 1864.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat or vessel called the Ed. Groswell of Buffalo whereof Richard Moon is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or Vessel was built at Rochester N.Y. in the year 1854 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port dated Oct. 11. 1865, and numbered 380, now surrendered, having changed Owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has no deck and no mast and that her length is 95 feet inches Capacity under tonnage deck 66.21 her breadth is 16 6/10 feet inches Capacity of enclosures 9.74 her depth is 5 2/10 feet inches 75.95 and that she measures 75 tons & 95 hundredths ninety-fifths that she is a Canal Boat has a round stern and no figure head.

And the said Char. M. King having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
