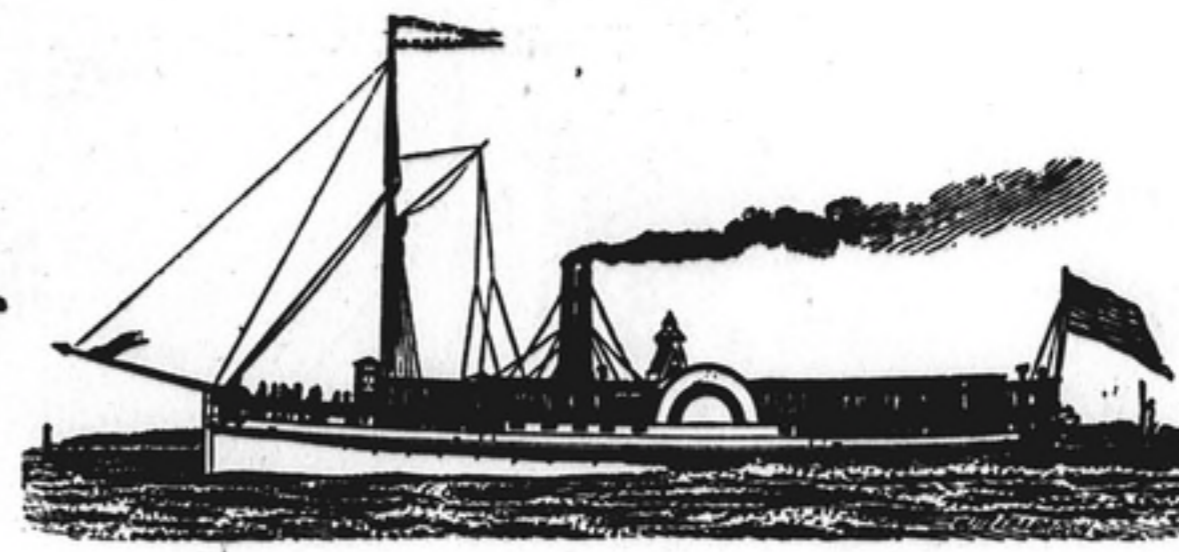

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1860. 17th June 1864 and the act of the 7th July 1838 29 July 1850 & 6 May 1864. *Wm O. Brown*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N.Y.* and that he is a

Surrendered and Temporary Papers issued having changed Owners & District.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the *York State* of *Buffalo* whereof *Edward Collins* is at present Master; and as he has sworn *Schooner* Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo N.Y.* State of in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated *May 1. 1865*, and numbered *90*, now surrendered, having *Head Room* added.

And *J. G. Butler* surveyor having certified that the said *Schooner* or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *133 ¹⁰/₁₀₀* feet — inches Capacity under tonnage deck *268.48* her breadth is *28 ⁷/₁₀* feet — inches Capacity of enclosures on upper deck *12.48* her depth is *11 ¹⁰/₁₀₀* feet — inches *280.96* and that she measures *280* tons *296 hundredths* and that she is a *Schooner* has a *square* stern and *scroll* head.

And the said *Wm O. Brown* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
