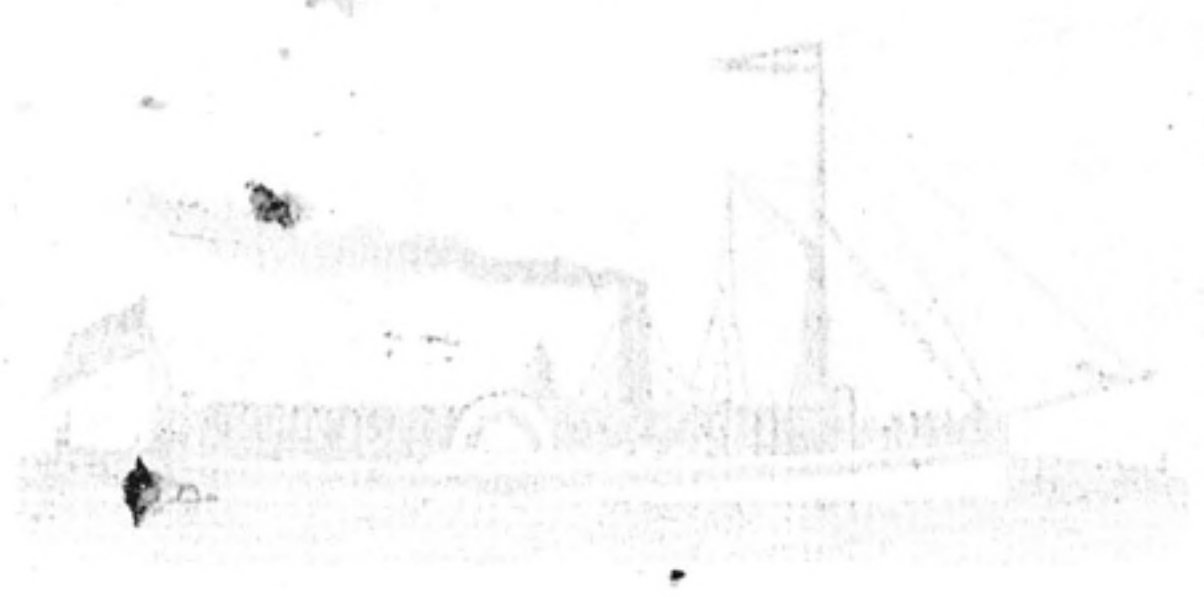

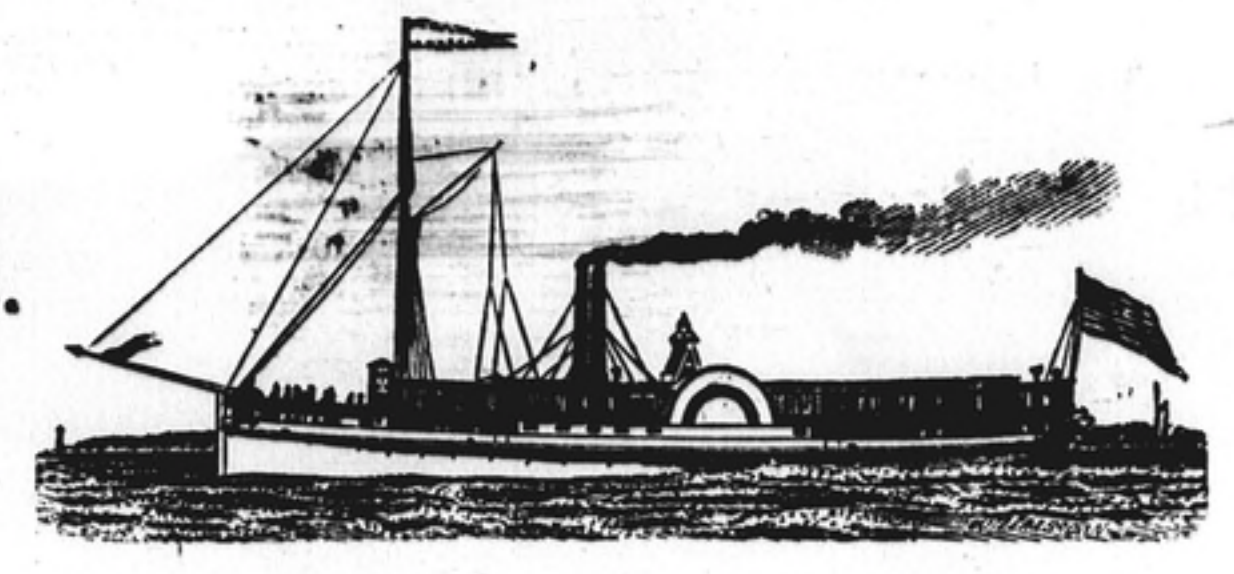

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1860. *the 17th June 1864 and the acts of the 7 July 1838, 29 July 1850 & 6 May 1864.*

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Barque or vessel called the L.C. Woodruff of Buffalo whereof B. F. Woolwin is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Barque or Vessel was built at Buffalo N.Y. in the year 1866, as appears by the Certificate of J. N. Jones, Shipwright, her builder, on file in this Office

And A. H. Sciven Surveyor having certified that the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 170 ³/₁₀ feet inches Capacity under tonnage deck 495.12 her breadth 33 feet inches Capacity of enclosures on upper decks 53.78 her depth 12 ²/₁₀ feet inches Total tonnage 548.90 tons & 90 hundredths ninety-fifths and that she measures 548 that she is a Barque has a square stern and serpents head.

And the said N. C. Winslow agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly enrolled at the FORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
