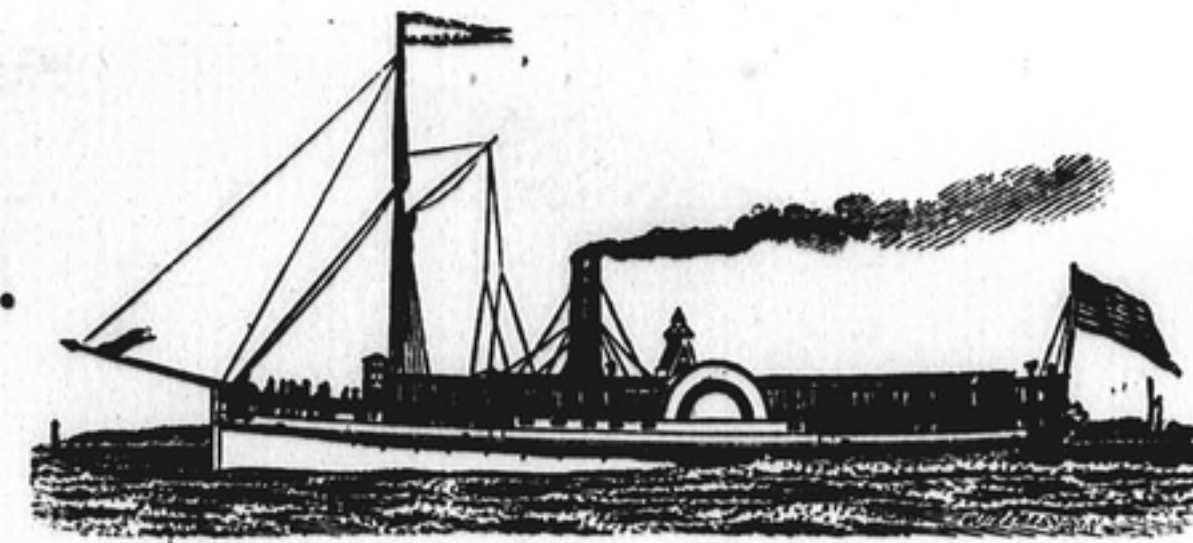

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1801, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 5th July, 1826, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Enrolling the Coasting Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1859. *July 1800 & 6th May 1864. The 17th June 1864 and the Acts of the 7th July 1838, 29*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N.Y.*, and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the *Sea Bird* of Buffalo whereof *Robt McElheron* is at present Master; and as he has sworn *Schooner* is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said *Schooner* or Vessel was built at *Buffalo, N.Y.* in the year *1857*, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated *Nov. 7th 1865*, and numbered *407*, now surrendered, having changed Owners

And *Said Enrollment* the said *Schooner* or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *136 5/10* feet *Capacity under tonnage deck 275.04* inches her breadth *26 5/10* feet *Capacity of enclosures on upper decks 9.28* inches her depth *11 2/10* feet *284.32* inches and that she measures *284* tons *1.32 hundredths* that she is a *Schooner* has a *square* stern and *plain* head.

And the said *Wm H. Ingram* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
