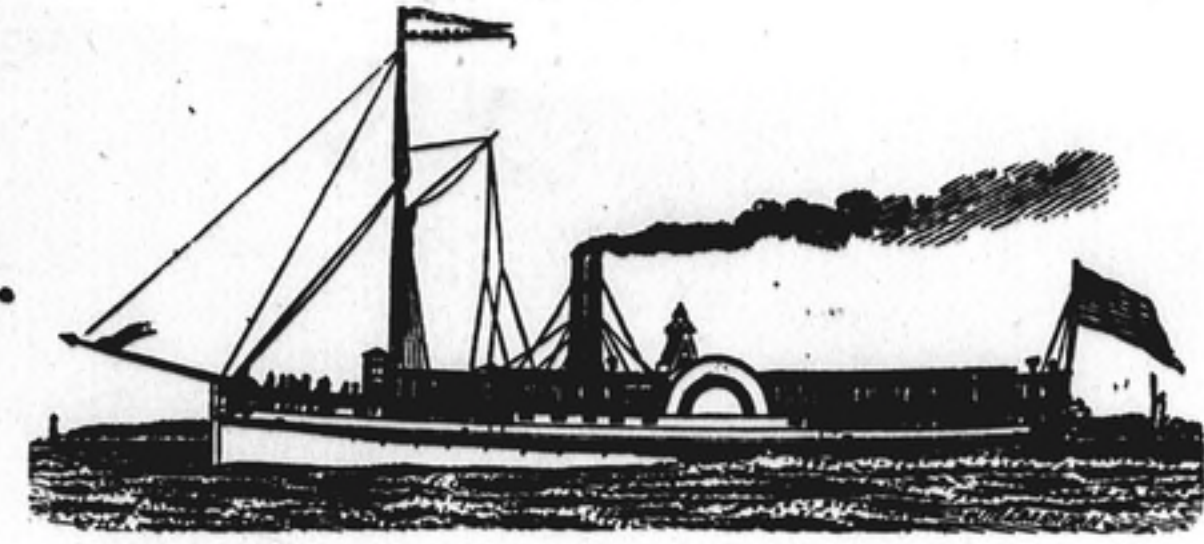

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1821, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Names of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1856. *They are the Acts of the 7th July 1838 and 29 July 1856 & 6 July 1864.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N.Y.*, and that *John Whalen* resides at the same place, and that they are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the *J. M. Lee* of *Buffalo* whereof *Edward Hoban* is at present Master; and as he has sworn *Schooner* Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Irving N.Y.* in the year *1854*, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated *April 28. 1865*, and numbered *75*, now surrendered, having changed Owners and having Head Room added.

And *Sanford Halbert*, surveyor having certified that the said *Schooner* or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *88 7/10* feet *Capacity under tonnage deck 76.05* inches her breadth *19 5/10* feet *Capacity of enclosures on upper deck 3.13* inches her depth *6 5/10* feet *79* tons *x 18 hundredths ninety-fifth* and that she measures *79* tons that she is a *Schooner* has a *square* stern and *scroll* head.

And the said *Edward Hoban* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
