

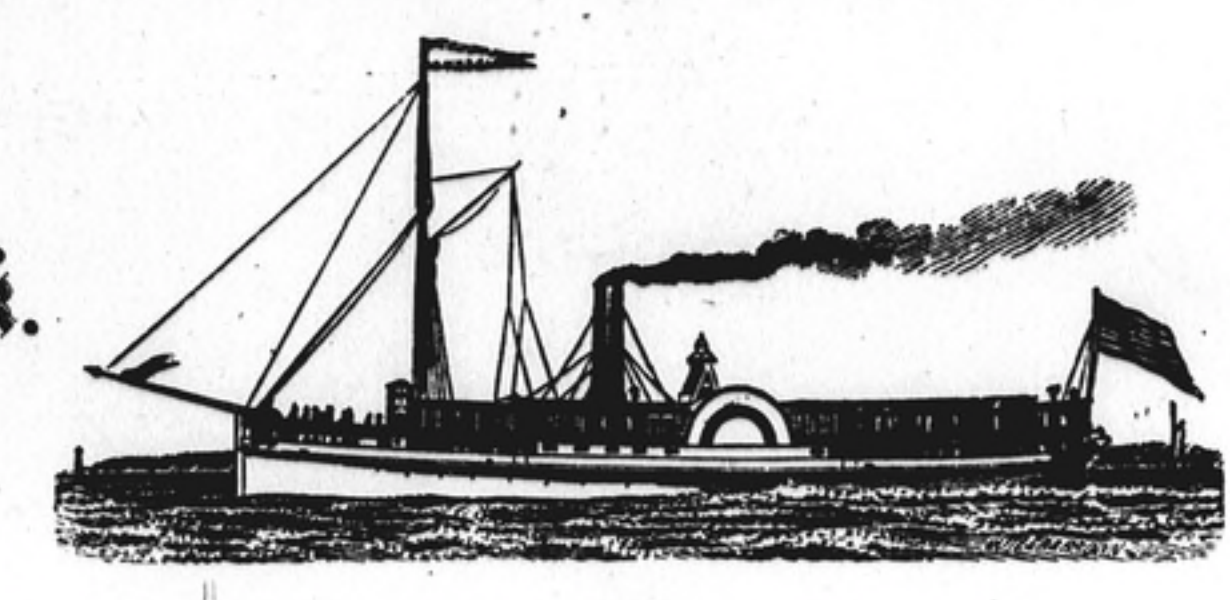

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1821, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Clearances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, the 17th June 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July 1838, 29th July 1850, and 6th May 1854.

Robert Byers

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat or vessel called the Dr. W. F. Nestern of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or Vessel was built at Buffalo N.Y. in the year 1865, as appears by the Certificate of C. A. Vanslyke shipwright her builder, on file in this Office

And A. H. Scirens surveyor having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 96 ⁴/₁₀ feet inches Capacity under tonnage deck 117.70 her breadth 17 ³/₁₀ feet inches Capacity of enclosures 2.54 her depth 8 ⁶/₁₀ feet inches 120.24 and that she measures 120 tons & 24 hundredths and that she is a Canal Boat has a round stern and plain head.

And the said Robert Byers having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
