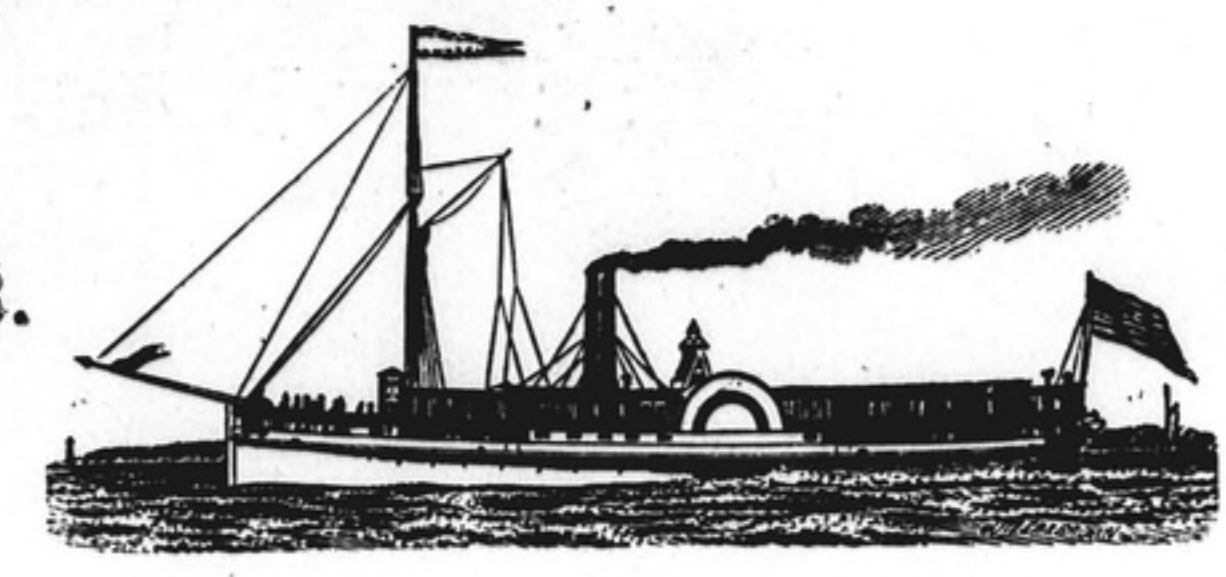

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1821, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyance of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1850, the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864,

Seth Clark

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y., and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig or vessel called the *Castalia* of Buffalo whereof Charles Graves is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said *Brig* or Vessel was built at Sandusky O. in the year 1847 State of and rebuilt in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated October 20, 1865, and numbered 390, now surrendered, having changed Owners and having Head Room added.

And Sanford Walbert, surveyor having certified that the said *Brig* or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 118 ¹/₁₀ feet — inches Capacity under tonnage deck 213.25 her breadth 25 ⁴/₁₀ feet — inches Capacity of enclosures on upper deck 7.79 her depth 9 ²/₁₀ feet — inches 221.04 and that she measures 221 tons ¹/₂ 04 hundredths ninety-fifths that she is a *Brig* has a square stern and no figure head.

And the said Seth Clark having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Brig* has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
