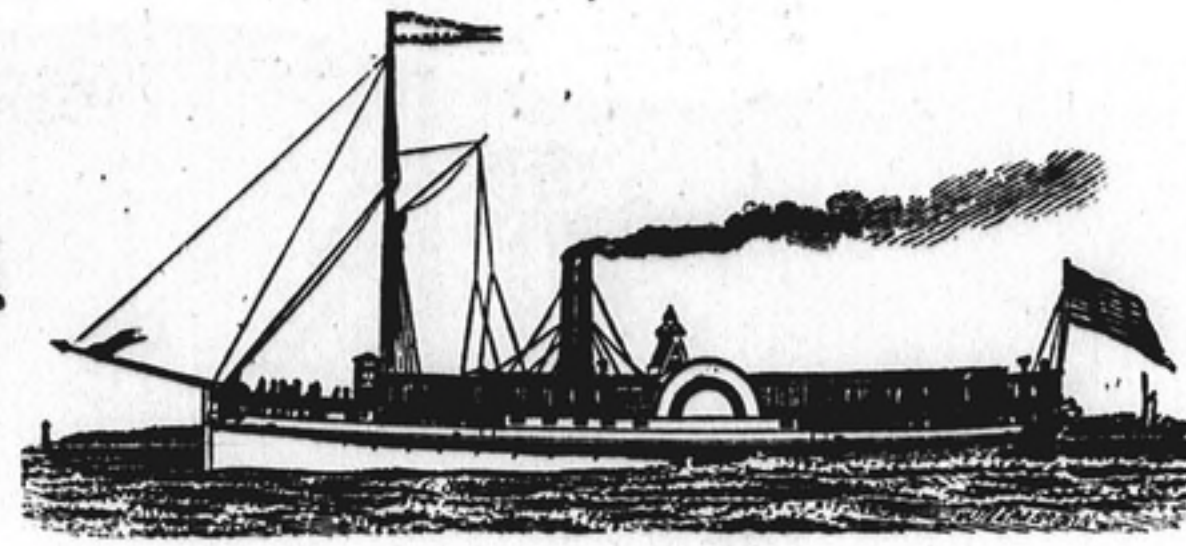

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1801; and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Certificates of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1850, the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July 1850, and 6th May 1864

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Barque* or vessel called the *Cha K Nims* of *Buffalo* whereof *Benjamin Hammonds* is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said *Barque* or Vessel was built at *Cleveland, Ohio,* State of *Ohio* in the year 18*66*, as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Enrollment, at the Port of *Cleveland*, dated *April 18. 1866*, and numbered *3*, now surrendered, having arrived at home port

And said Enrollment having certified that the said *Barque* or vessel has *one* deck and *three* masts and that her length is *163 1/10* feet *inches* Capacity under tonnage decks *469.82* her breadth *32 7/10* feet *inches* Capacity of enclosures on upper deck *44.57* her depth *13 7/10* feet *inches* *514.39* tons & 39 hundredths *hundred-fiftys* and that she measures *514* that she is a *Barque* has a *square* and *figure* stern head.

And the said *Sarah E. Nims* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Barque* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
