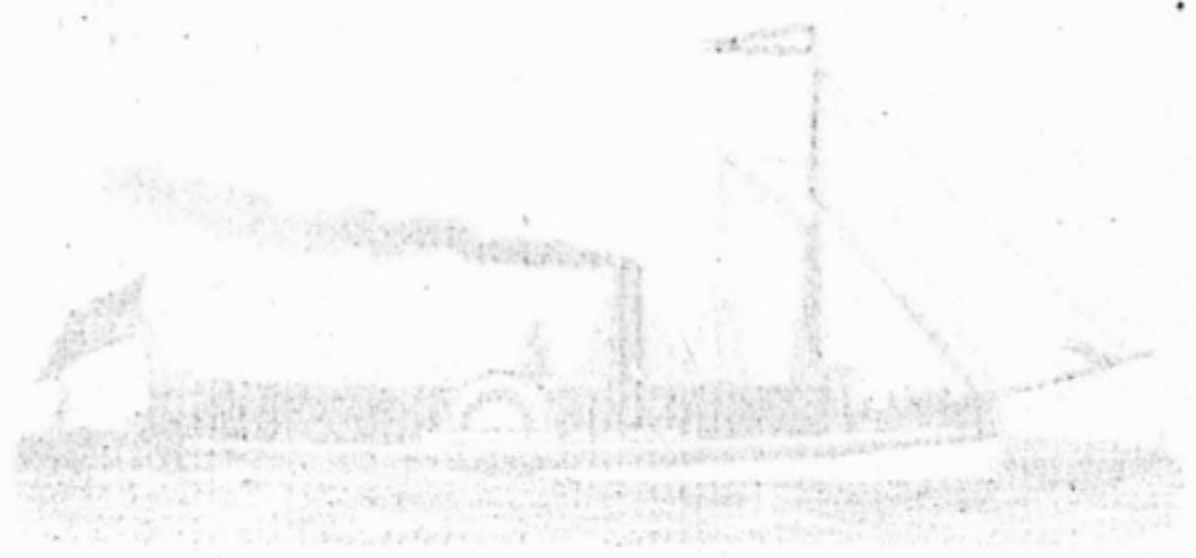


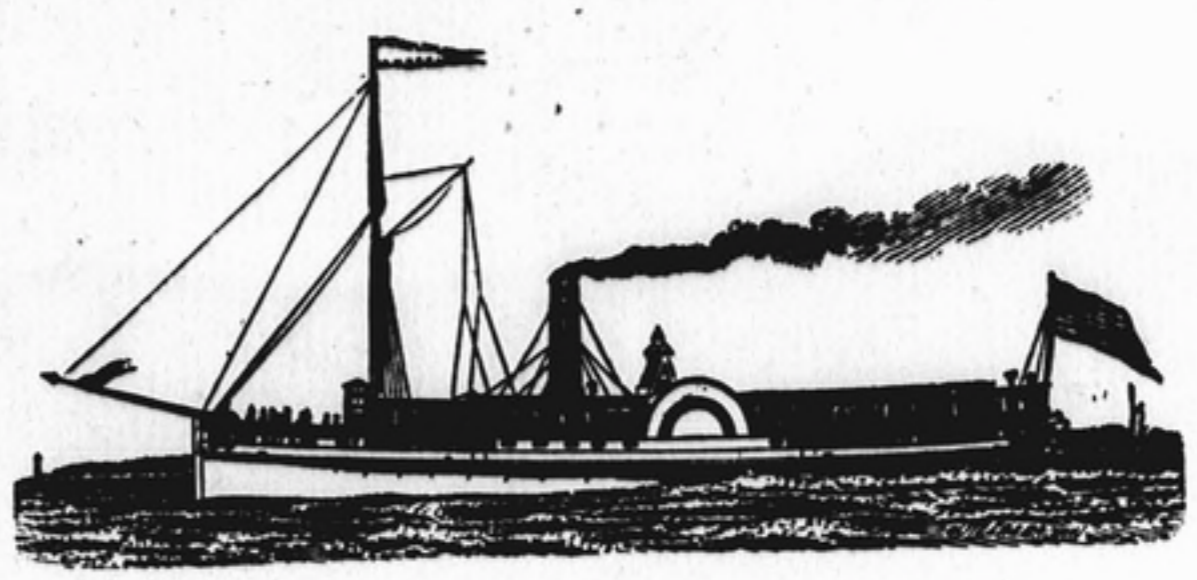

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 24, 1821, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1828, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, the 17th June 1864, and the acts of the 7th July 1838, 29th July 1850, and 6th May 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and she is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig or vessel called The Young America of Buffalo whereof Andrew T. Baldwin is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Brig or Vessel was built at Buffalo, State of New York in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her last enrollment at this port, dated May 5, 1865, and numbered 122, now surrendered having changed Owners + ~~State~~.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 129 ⁹⁵/₁₀₀ feet inches Capacity under tonnage deck 231.47 her breadth 25 ⁸/₁₀ feet inches " of enclosure on deck 11.52 her depth 10 ⁴⁸/₁₀₀ feet inches 242.99 and that she measures 242 tons 99 hundredths that she is a Brig. has a square stern and scroll head. having

And the said Ann D. Bird agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
