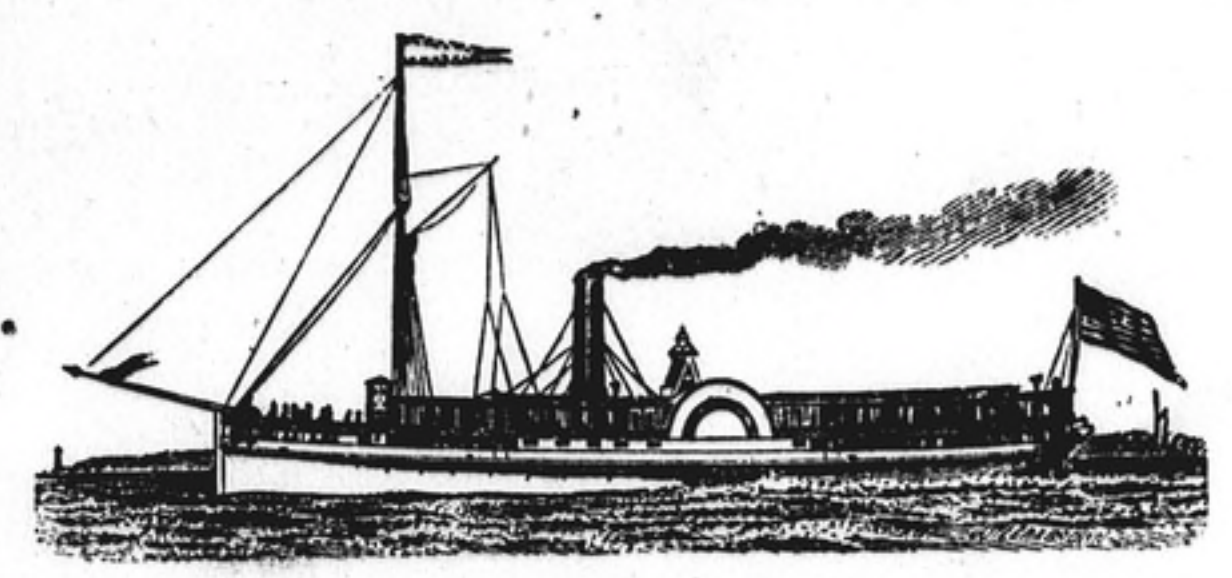

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 23, 1801, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1808, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Certificates of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 20th, 1859, the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

James J. Falck

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and owns one half (1/2) and that John Johnson resides at the same place, and owns one half (1/2), and that they are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or vessel called the R. J. Skidmore of Buffalo whereof James J. Falck is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Schooner or Vessel was built at Trenton State of Michigan in the year 1856 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated May 2, 1866 and numbered 96, now surrendered having changed Owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 93 feet Capacity under tonnage deck 107.78 her breadth is 21 8/10 feet Capacity of enclosures on upper deck 14.31 her depth 7 7/10 feet inches 112 tons x 9 hundredths ninety-sixths and that she measures 112 tons and that she is a Schooner has a square stern and plain head.

And the said James J. Falck agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
