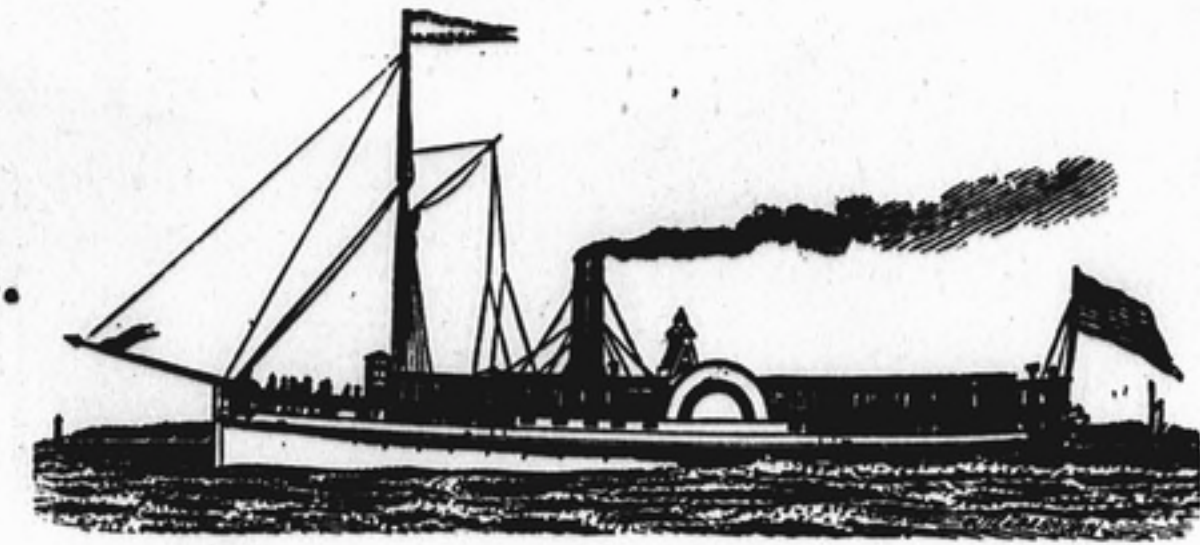

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1859, the 17th of June 1864, and the acts of the 7th of May 1838, 29th July 1850 and the 6th of May 1864.
B. A. Root, Secretary of the Western Transportation Co. of Tonawanda, N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Tug. Prop. or vessel called the "Dragon" of Buffalo whereof James Drake is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Tug. Prop. or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1866, as appears by the Certificate of Vanslyke and Notter Shipwrights her builders, on file in this office.

And A. H. Scriven, Surveyor, having certified that the said Tug. Prop. or vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 62 ⁷/₁₀ feet inches capacity under tonnage deck 30.65 her breadth 14 ⁷/₁₀ feet inches " Enclosure on upper deck. 2.29 her depth 6 ⁸/₁₀ feet inches 32 tons 90 hundredths ninety-fifths and that she measures 32 tons Round stern and no head.

And the said B. A. Root having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Tug. Prop. has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
