In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

Andrew Abernethy
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N. Y. and owns one half (1/2) and that John Melvin resides at the same ^{place} and owns the remaining one half (1/2) and that they are

Citizens of the United States
sole owner of the Canal Boat or vessel called the Maria Melvin, of Buffalo whereof William Hemstreet is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat or vessel was built at Buffalo N. Y. in the year 1863, as appears by the Certificate of her former enrollment, at this port dated May 5, 1865, and numbered 124, the Certificate of which has been withheld or lost, now enrolled having changed owners. And Ira Barnard Jr. Surveyor having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast, and that her length is 94 feet, her breadth 7 feet, her depth 8 feet, her height 10 feet, and that she measures 117 tons and 80 hundredths,

that she is a Canal Boat has a Square stern and no figure head and the said Andrew Abernethy having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said Acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N.
