In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

the said Sugg. Propeller vessel has one deck and no mast, and  
that her length is 38 2/10 feet,  
her breadth 19 8/10 feet,  
her depth 14 5/10 feet,  
her height 10 1/10 feet,  
and that she measures 6 tons and 49 hundredths,
