In Conformity, to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for enrolling and Licensing Ships or Vessels, &c." passed the 18th Feb. 1793, and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 17th June, 1864, and the Acts of the 7th July, 1838, 29th July, 1850, and 6th May, 1864.

sole owner of the Canal Boat vessel called the *H. Dwight* of Buffalo whereof *Levi Leonard*

is at present Master, and as he hath sworn is a citizen of the United States, and that the said Canal Boat vessel was built at Phoenix, N. Y. in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the port of Oswego, dated June 24, 1862, and numbered 95, now surrendered, having changed owners, ^{in subject} having been remeasured by *A. H. Scriber, Surveyor*, having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast, and

that her length is 95 feet,
her breadth 17 feet,
her depth 8 feet,
her height 10 feet,
and that she measures 119 tons and 42 hundredths,
