Y. in the year 1861, as appears by her last Enrollment at this port, dated Oct. 5. 1865, and numbered 371. The Certificate of which has been lost or destroyed as appears by the Oath of James H. Kelderhouse on file in this Office and Ira Barnard Jr. Surveyor, having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast, and

that her length is 95 feet,
her breadth 17 feet,
her depth 8 feet,
her height 10 feet,
and that she measures 117 tons and 44 hundredths,
